We are pleased to welcome you into the APRO Field Investigators Network. Your permanent ID card, designating you as a Field Investigator, is enclosed.

The APRO Field Investigators Network has been created so that the Organization will have available qualified individuals who can conduct investigations of UFO incidents in their respective areas, promptly and accurately. If and when we receive information on a UFO observation in your area (and that seems worthy of your time and effort) we will immediately notify you. Meanwhile, we suggest you constantly be on the alert as it is likely that you will hear of such incidents before we do. In such cases, please feel free to initiate investigations, informing us at the same time so that we do not assign another person to the case. If you are unable to investigate a case in your area, please inform us of this so that we can attempt to find another investigator for that particular case.

The APRO Staff is currently preparing a manual titled Standard Procedures for APRO Field Investigators which will be mailed to you free of charge when it is completed. This manual should help guide you when you are investigating UFO incidents.

If you should change address, please notify us immediately, providing us with your new address and telephone number/s. Please sign this change of address notice with "Field Investigator" so that it will be given priority by the Membership Department.

If you are in the Service stationed abroad, please inform us of your location and changes of location for our records. Your bulletin will be mailed to your APO/FPO address, but this gives us no idea of which country you are stationed in.
