

Potential Threat and Question of Survival:

1955 and 1962. General DOUGLAS MacARTHUR, Comdr. in Chief Allied Forces in the Pacific, World War II, statesman;

(Excerpts) "...because of the development of science all the countries on earth will have to unite to survive and to make a common front against attack by people from other planet." (Waldorf Astoria, New York Times, Oct. 8, 1955) - "...ULTIMATE CONFLICT BETWEEN A UNITED HUMAN RACE AND THE SINISTER FORCES OF SOME PLANETARY GALAXY." (West Point Military Academy, May 12, 1962)

1968. NATIONAL SECURITY AGENCY, Report: "UFO Hypothesis and Survival Questions":

(Exerpts) "Human history has shown us time and again the tragic results of a confrontation between a technologically superior civilization and technologically inferior people." "...IT WOULD BE GEARED TO DEVELOPING ADEQUATE DEFENSIVE MEASURES IN A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF TIME. - It would seem a little more of this survival attitude is called for in dealing with the UFO problem."

1978, U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT, Office of International Security. Director Dr. MICHAEL A.G. MICHAUD, diplomat, declared on a conference on June 1978:

(Excerpt) "Aliens from other solar systems are a potential threat to us, and we are a potential threat to them." ... "This includes the possibility of military action."

Dr. IRWIN PICUS, Dep. Dir. of the Office of Space Affairs declared:

(Excerpt) "Contact with other-world beings is something that would have tremendous repercussions if it happened and we weren't prepared."

1981. NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL response to ICUFON's UFO Memorandum to Pres.
RONALD REAGAN on November 21, 1981:

(Excerpt) "The President is well aware of the threat (UFO forces) you document so clearly and is doing all in his power to restore the national defense margin of safety as quickly and prudently as possible. - Sincerely, Robert L. Schweitzer Major General, US Army".

1984, PRIME MINISTER OF UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN and NORTHERN ISLAND,
response via British Embassy, Washington DC, on ICUFON UFO Memorandum on June 1, '84:

(Excerpts) "...the Prime Minister is grateful to you for bringing to our attention... the potential international security threat posed by UFOs."

1985. U.S. PRESIDENT RONALD REAGAN and USSR, SECRETARY GENERAL MICHAEL GORBACHEV SUMMIT MEETING, November 18-20, Geneva, Switzerland.;

1, President Reagan's address on 21 Nov, at 9:00 p.m. to the Congress in Washington D.C. (Transcript, New York Times, Nov. 22, 1985);

(Excerpt) "Mr. Gorbachev insisted that we might use a strategic defense system to put offensive weapons into space and establish nuclear superiority," Who and where is the enemy at all of the USA and the USSR in outer space, WHICH WOULD NECESSITATE 'NUCLEAR SUPERIORITY'? (There are the UFO forces!)

2. President Reagan address on Dec 4, 1985, at the Fallston, MD, High School
before Governor Hughes, Senator Mathias, Repr. Bentley, Repr. of the Board of
Education, the administration, the faculty and the student. (White House Release):

(Excerpts) "...one point in our discussions privately with General Secretary Gorbachev!..suddenly there was a threat to this world from some other species from another planet outside in the universe, we'd forget all the little local differences that we have between our countries and we would find out and for all that we really are all human beings here on this earth together.

Well, I DON'T SUPPOSE WE CAN WAIT FOR SOME ALIEN RACE TO COME DOWN AND THREATEN US, BUT I THINK THAT BETWEEN US, WE CAN BRING ABOUT THAT REALIZATION."
