Dear Mr. Hellyer:

I am engaged in research on the subject of Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs) and have in my files a report from the Ottawa Journal of July 20, 1967 of an interview with you by Victor J. Mackie.

You disclosed at that time that the Canadian Government, 13 years previously, had made available the Defence Research Board experimental station at Suffield, Alberta, as a landing site for UFOs, but that nothing ever materialized from the top secret project.

I wish to obtain your personal confirmation that such a site was made available for that purpose, and also wish to know the reason why this was done, i.e., what was the object of the exercise.

I will be very grateful for your co-operation in this matter.
