Items of 25 June 1954 re Magnet Sound Story, from G.C.W. Burness, Controller of Telecommunications, to Supt. of Radio Regulations -

"Mr. Baldwin (the DM) has informed me that no facts had emerged to warrant making this a special government project.

.... Mr. Smith should be told that he can continue in his own free time, not on departmental time. He may continue to use departmental equipment not otherwise in use, ... etc...."

Remainder of file contains large number of letters of inquiry from private citizens, plus some sighting reports and miscellaneous correspondence, but nothing else of interest other than noted above.

Vol. II same file No. - dormant - 1 April 1956 to March 23, 1966

This volume contains a number of UFO sighting reports by private citizens and one from a CP air pilot. The usual letter of acknowledgement of sighting reports, signed by WBS, says "This department does not make any analysis of these sightings" Letter of 16 Feb '59 to a citizen (F.B. Cote) from RCMP, says

"over a period of years, certain info. was received by this force relating to UFOs. Investigations were made and the findings forwarded to the Chairman, Defence Research Board, DND."
