Dear Brian:

I finally managed to spend some time with Millman, and I deposited a large chunk of our "ton of metal" with him for lab analysis. I will await the report with interest.

With regard to the Neal case, I am sorry to report that it is closed as far as NRC is concerned. Millman insists the report already made covers the whole situation as far as they are concerned and there is nothing further they can do. I understand you have this report. I also tried the DND photo lab but they can do nothing unless requested by NRC in UFO cases. There is therefore nothing else which I can do here in Ottawa, at least at this time. Too bad, because I think this photo has strange aspects about it.

NRC has nothing on the reported landing in Westmeath Township. It seems that no one reported it to them. They have only a useless report on the half hour sighting near Petawawa where some low passes were made over the witnesses in a car. The report is from CFB petawawa and says next to nothing and it was on this basis that NRC ignored it - there was no indication at all of anything really unusual - just a light in the sky, and NRC does not go after such things.

With respect to the situation on the NRC files, it seems clear to me now that it is simply a case of NRC having done nothing at all that has resulted in their files being so bare. They receive a report, nearly always a copy rather than an original, have a look at it and decide that there is no apparent indication of scientific payoff, and that ends the matter. Hence, nothing accumulates on the case concerned, except the odd letter which they receive, and answer. Millman stresses that their main concern is simply to maintain files on sightings - and this, I must confess, they do. For all practical purposes, the matter ends there.

That seems to be all I have for you at present, Brian. Keep up the good work.
