Dear Dr. Millman:

I am writing to you as a follow-up on recent correspondence on your file MA5-1-101, between Mr. Brian Cannon, Director of CAPRO in Winnipeg, and yourself. You will, of course, remember that you and I discussed UFOs on a TV show together the latter part of last November.

In Mr. Cannon's letter to you of May 1, 1968, he stated that he would ask me to contact you in respect to my arranging to peruse the files in the possession of NRC which I understand you identify as your Non-Meteoritic Sighting files.

You are already aware of my deep interest in this subject and I will therefore appreciate an opportunity to view your files at some early date.

I might add that I am surprised that NRC has not obtained a copy of a book titled SCIENCE, THE PUBLIC AND THE UFO (you know the author) which deals with various aspects of science in relation to the UFO mystery. I am under the impression that scientific investigations require the consideration of all facts which may be relevant, and that a study of the existing literature is necessary in order to determine what ground has already been covered, and what has not. This book covers many areas which are overlooked in official scientific investigations.

I hope to hear from you soon, Dr. Millman, and I send you my kindest personal regards.
