

\$6,000... Up, up and away

The Canada Council will spend \$6,000 for a collection and interpretation of reported UFO sightings across the country.

John B. Musgrave of Edmonton will receive the \$6,000 grant — the first the council has ever given for UFO studies.

The grant is being made under the \$286,948 Explorations Program to encourage "new forms of expression, communication and public participation in the arts, humanities and social sciences and work on Cana-

da's cultural and historical heritage."

Other grants under the program announced today included:

—to Kevin Gillis of Chesterville, \$5,000 to study the role of the harmonica in the social culture of each region of Canada;

—to Sharlene Janice Larmour, Mississauga, \$5,486 to explore the uses of northern vegetation in fibre dyeing;

—to the Evelyn Roth Moving Sculpture Co. of Vancouver, \$13,000 for an experiment with new, moving sculptural shapes in relation to contemporary music.

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
