FACTS ABOUT NICAP AND THE UFO PROBLEM

1. NICAP is a non-profit, fact-finding organization incorporated in the District of Columbia. Policy is established by the Board of Governors and carried out by the executive staff, with the help of the Panel of Special Advisers, Affiliates, and investigative Subcommittees.
2. Associate Membership in NICAP, at \$5.00 per year, entitles members to all issues of the bi-monthly UFO Investigator and NICAP Bulletins, a membership card, and eligibility for membership in local NICAP Affiliates.
3. The purpose of NICAP is to investigate unidentified flying objects (UFOs) and claims relative to UFO activity, and to offset official secrecy. Two major goals are: Open Congressional hearings to end the controversy and make the facts public, and scientific investigation of UFOs.
4. Theories: Two leading current theories about UFOs consider them to be extraterrestrial space ships, U.S. or Russian secret devices. Official statements, on the whole, have attributed UFO reports to delusion, illusion and hallucination. NICAP considers UFOs to be unknown objects under intelligent control.
