

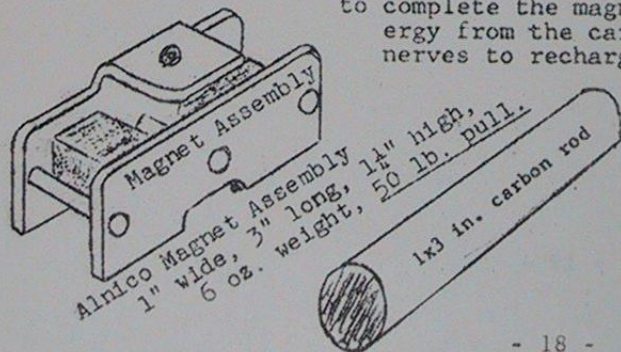

BSRA NO. 11 - VITIC - Research project on the physiological effects of Carbon Rod in one hand and an Alnico Magnet in the other, from data assembled by Brian Brown in "Dynamic Power of the Mind", from Nandor Fodor on Reichenbach and Odic force, and miscellaneous notes by Meade Layne and Yada di Shi'ite on inducing increased vitality, known only to secret priesthoods of Egypt and Tibet. Added information from Count Walewski on Sun (Carbon) Rod and Moon (Magnetic Iron) Rod, with special diagram of pulsed vortex of magnetic energy suggested by Dr. Anton Mesmer through a medium in Pomona, California in 1960. Mesmer's diagram calls for two powerful Alnico magnets mounted so they pull toward each other, but far enough apart so one hand can be placed between them, holding the unmagnetized iron or steel rod. A one-loop coil of insulated copper wire, with ends overlapping, about 6" in diameter is around the steel handle. The other hand holds a 1x6 inch carbon rod, or bundle of smaller rods.

Alnico Magnets will do, about 50 lb. pull each.
