

This must be followed by a detailed study of the report by a team of scientific experts at the Center for UFO Studies. The reliability of the witnesses must have been confirmed beyond any doubt, they must agree substantially on what they saw, and must have described the phenomenon reasonably well. If the phenomenon reported can be positively classified as "unidentified" and the foregoing requirements of the witnesses have been met, then the photo can be compared with the descriptions in the report to determine if they match.

If the photo is then found to contain all the details reported by the witnesses, including the background (e.g., clouds, trees, rooftops, power lines, etc.) then that photo can be considered as valid photographic proof of the UFO reported.

The detailed step by step procedure to obtain this evidence is outlined in the Table.
