GEORGE A. ADAMSKI, WAS. SM - C. REBUTELCAL 12-14-53. ADAMSKI CONTACTED 12-17-53, PALOMAR GARDENS CAFE (RESIDENCE), VALLEY CENTER, CALIFORNIA, BY AGENTS [REDACTED] (OSI), [REDACTED] (FBI), AND [REDACTED] (FBI). ADAMSKI WAS EMPHATICALLY ADMONISHED THAT HE WAS IMMEDIATELY TO CEASE AND DESIST IN REFERRING TO THE FBI OR OSI AS HAVING GIVEN HIM APPROVAL TO SPEAK ON FLYING SAUCERS. HE WAS ALSO ADMONISHED TO CEASE AND DESIST IN MENTIONING THE NAMES OF ANY OSI OR FBI AGENTS OR INFERRING THAT THEY HAD CLEARED ANY OF HIS SPEECHES, MATERIALS, OR WRITINGS. ADAMSKI WAS ADVISED LEGAL ACTION WOULD BE TAKEN AGAINST HIM IF HE PERSISTED IN INFERRING OR MAKING THESE STATEMENTS. THE COPY OF THE SIGNED STATEMENT DATED 3-17-53, RETAINED BY ADAMSKI, WAS VOLUNTARILY RETURNED TO SA [REDACTED] AND IS BEING RETAINED IN THE FILES OF THIS OFFICE.
