Dear Dr. Smith:

Further to my recent letter concerning the piece of metal, I am now enclosing photostat copies of the metallographic analysis ~~analysis~~ and photographs taken during a chemical analysis of the metal carried out in Montreal, as mentioned in my previous letter.

Also enclosed are re-prints of earlier photographs taken of the metal. No. 1 shows the mass of metal, with protusion, as taken in a government laboratory where limited tests and analyses were undertaken by the late Wilbert B. Smith who was, at that time, Chief of Telecommunications, Department of Transport. The white lines shown on the metal were put there by Mr. Smith for identification purposes. No. 2 shows an enlargement of one of the inclusions on the outside surface of the metal, taken with the aid of microphotography.

I shall look forward to hearing further from you after your inspection of the metal on the outside property of Wing-Comm. A.W. Riddell this Saturday.
