N 74/052 (14 July 74) over Charlevoix (P.Q.)
 (reported through NRHO North Bay)

Scandinavian Airlines Pilot reported one object,
 triangular in shape, est. at 33,000', moving SW.

Also, apparently reported by another A/C, flying at 55,000
 feet, object at 40,000'. This A/C was 3 to 40 mi. SE of
 Quebec City. Radiofrequency interference at Baginville
 during time of sighting. (7 minutes).

N 74/053 A Mrs. Decourville in St. Clotilde
 St. Clotilde de Buxton (Quebec, 819-336-2063)
 reported a triangular UFO "with a wiggling tail"
 on 15 July. Boston reported that a
 balloon would be in area 7.6 mi. NW of
 Millinocket, alt. 50,000'.

A Mr. Zorn (farmer) smothering rape when
 5 UFOs were seen to hover about one foot off
 ground over his field for 15 mins. Walked towards
 them & came to within 20 ft. of them before they
 "propelled straight up disappearing into the clouds".
 5 ~~burned~~ wings circular patterns (distinct circles)
 left by UFOs caused by something exerting what had
 to be heavy air or exhaust pressure over the high
 grass. Grass flattened in circular circles - 2 of 12'
 and 3 of 10 1/2' diameter. Grass in centre untouched
 being unit raised by RCMP. Objects revolving rapidly by
