

Editorial...

We are moving...and, in the process, we are expanding our operations to a broader base...effective March 1, 1981.

Because of the increasing costs of maintaining a rented office and paid personnel, we are shifting gears at CUFOS. Before the end of February, we will move into no-rent quarters and will shift to volunteer personnel for the entire organization. We regret that the tight economy is forcing us to do this, but we believe we will, in the long run, strengthen the organization and bring a larger number of highly-qualified volunteers into more active participation with UFO research and education through the Center for UFO Studies.

Beginning March 1, 1981, you will have two addresses for CUFOS. All correspondence to Dr. Hynek or to Mimi Hynek relating to research, case investigation or Center Information Services publication (our editorial offices) should be sent to CUFOS, P.O. Box 1402, Evanston, Illinois 60204.

The second address is a new one and is for all correspondence relating to the ASSOCIATE NEWSLETTER, the ASSOCIATE program, financial matters and routine business activities of CUFOS. The new address is CUFOS, P.O. Box 1621, Lima, Ohio 45802 and will be the center of activities for John Timmerman, the Editor of this publication, the Treasurer and the Chairman of CUFOS.

Don't worry about sending something to the wrong office. We will be interchanging information by forwarding mail on a daily basis and there will be little delay if you send something to Dr. Hynek which should have been sent to the business office in Lima, or visa versa.

All CUFOS periodicals will continue to be published. These are the CUFOS ASSOCIATE NEWSLETTER (monthly) and the CUFOS BULLETIN (quarterly) which are mailed to contributing ASSOCIATES only, the CUFOS INVESTIGATORS QUARTERLY which is mailed to field investigators only, the FRONTIERS OF SCIENCE (bi-monthly) which is mailed to some ASSOCIATES or by subscription, the JOURNAL OF UFO STUDIES which is mailed to some ASSOCIATES or by subscription, plus others now in the planning stages.

Dr. Hynek will take over the investigative and editorial work of Allan Hendry, writing the BULLETIN and the IUR section of FRONTIERS OF SCIENCE. John Timmerman will continue to produce the ASSOCIATE NEWSLETTER, mailing it from Lima, Ohio and maintaining all ASSOCIATE records and a new computerized system for communications throughout the organization. Work previously performed by Estelle Postol in Evanston will be divided between the Evanston and the Lima offices with the assistance of volunteers in both locations.

For those who do not recognize the title, FRONTIERS OF SCIENCE is a new magazine owned by Center for UFO Studies which merges what were previously published as SECOND LOOK and INTERNATIONAL UFO REPORTER. It is edited by Elizabeth Philip and all matters relating to that magazine, including subscriptions, should be addressed to her at 8 E. Street, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20003.

Other special services of CUFOS will be announced in future editions of this NEWSLETTER, so watch for them.

With these changes, it is our intention to redirect the application of funds less to administrative expense and more to research and educational services. We will make every effort to avoid inconvenience for any of you. Thank you very much for your cooperation and assistance by remaining a participating ASSOCIATE of the Center for UFO Studies.
