TO THE DIRECTOR, CIVIL AVIATION:

I am offering the following for whatever help it might provide. Our knowledge of basic science is, to say the least, inadequate and some of our ideas about the structure of matter are actually erroneous.

The reality of matter as it manifests to our awareness consists of the derived fields of basic spin, among which are the density, gradient, divergence and curl. These are only partially recognized at present. We are familiar with the effects of these fields but not to any extent with the fields themselves, or with how they interact to form matter as we know it.

The scientific aspects and how I came into possession of this information are not particularly relevant at the moment. The important matter is the bearing which this information has on the structural failures of aircraft and various other objects.

The inverse square law for the forces between material particles is approximately valid only for the intermediate range of distances within our experience. It does not apply at extremely large or extremely small distances. Furthermore, the forces which we observe are resultants, not basic forces. The basic forces are the consequences of the distribution of the fields comprising the reality of matter. This distribution is sinusoidal, and the resultant forces are the consequences of the harmonic combination of all the fields present.

Matter is held together by the equilibrium of all the forces acting within it, and the alteration of any of the fields reflects in the binding forces within the matter.

Not all the fields within matter are due to that particular chunk of matter, or even to matter itself, as the field structure within which matter is immersed may be altered by many outside influences.

This all means that the binding forces within matter are not the fixed and immutable quantities we have believed them to be.

On this earth, and reasonably close to its surface, the field structure is predominantly constant, except for certain regions, and matter displays reasonably stable characteristics throughout the world.

However, there do exist certain regions which may be termed Vortices, in which one or more of the fields are different from the values generally prevailing elsewhere. Within these regions there may be substantial changes in the binding forces of matter, depending upon the nature and extent of the field differences.

Based upon this understanding of the nature of matter I devised and constructed several instruments to detect changes in the binding forces of matter. These instruments were given to friends in various parts of the world who have reported changes in binding forces in some regions.

The instruments consist of a nylon fiber stressed to $\frac{1}{2}$ its breaking strength by a metal spring stressed well below its ultimate strength. Alteration of the binding force affects the nylon and metal differently and one or the other elongates. This motion is transferred to a spindle and pointer.

While I can give no indication of the magnitude of the changes in binding force in these various regions, I do know that they exist and that the changes are appreciable. I am convinced that at least some of the structure failures of aircraft are due to the machines flying through regions where the reduction in binding force brought the strength of a highly stressed part below the load level it was expected to carry.

I do not know whether these regions of reduced binding force are fixed in position or move about but I expect that they do both.

I would therefore recommend that:

- (a) A larger factor of safety in the stressing of aircraft components be used until this phenomenon is better understood
- (b) The regions of reduced binding be searched out, mapped and studied, looking towards their eventual compensation.

Dear Mr. Schultz:

Thank you for your letter of May 23, 1954 and the enclosed thesis dealing with metaphysical ether.

I must admit that I was somewhat disappointed in your document because it added very little to what we have already. For your information we have already established a necessary and sufficient condition for the space time continuum (ether) which will permit the postulation of the basic parameters on which our world of matter, as we know it, must be based. Based on this primary necessary and sufficient condition one of our group has completed the development of an atomic theory which meets all of our experimental data. This theory is now undergoing close scientific scrutiny.

It does appear from the work which we have done so far that other worlds having different spin factors can exist and we were hoping to turn up some factual data which would allow us to compute the necessary conversion factors for these other worlds.

I can assure you that we have already done most of the work which you have outlined in your thesis although we have done it in accordance with strictly rigid scientific philosophy, the same type of scientific treatment which is used in orthodox science. Since we have every confidence in this approach and it is understandable by anyone who has had a certain amount of scientific training, we prefer to work along these lines although we are not at all averse to receiving tips and clues from any source whatsoever.

We appreciate particularly the bibliography which you included in your thesis. Many of the writings which you have indicated we have already investigated but we may take advantage of your kind offer to loan us some of the other books which we have not so far investigated. Any further information which you can give us will, of course, be much appreciated.

Dear Mr. Schultz,

I hope that you will pardon my answering your letter of February 3, on a personal basis. Frankly, my associates do not consider that most of the material which you were good enough to send contributes very much to our study of the saucer phenomenon. However, I feel that the trouble is more likely in presentation than subject matter, and I feel that there is probably much more there than we are getting out of it.

Our group consists of scientists and engineers in several different fields. Several of them are considered to be authorities in their own lines, and we have all had a thorough training in what are considered to be the basic principles of physics and mathematics. We have no reason to doubt the validity of these principles, although we are the first to admit that they may be quite inadequate to express more than a very small portion of our universe.

Our difficulty is that we are unable to find specific common ground between what your group is offering and what we are used to working with. As you know, our modern science is predicated almost entirely on equations, which are handled by mathematical manipulations which were developed by the application of the most rigid logic. What we require therefore, is something which we can link to our equations. Failing that, we require some other formal pattern of logic which is self consistent, into which we can fit your material, and from which we may derive conclusions amenable to experimental confirmation. We do not consider the mere authoritative statement of something to constitute a fact, but ask, rather that we be shown how to confirm the fact for ourselves, if we are so minded. As you no doubt appreciate, in modern science all facts are equally available for confirmation by any careful experimenter who has the necessary equipment available, and are not restricted to a favored few who may be peculiarly constituted to explore them.

Several members of our group, including myself, have investigated psychical phenomena of various types and are familiar with the peculiar conditions which surround this subject. We feel, nevertheless, that scientific methods can be used in this field with good success, and we have used these methods ourselves to advantage.

In general, it is my own wish to glean the maximum knowledge from the material which your group have so generously provided, but in order to do this, I am afraid I shall have to request some kind of translation into the language of the science with which I am familiar. If I may be permitted to ask a few questions, you might be able to obtain answers which will provide the necessary clues for us to work with.

One question which is bothering us considerably is that of energy and momentum levels. We are aware that so far as our material universe is concerned at least, the laws of conservation of energy and momentum, and mass equivalents are inviolate. If, however, these laws are merely extensions of some law of wider scope we would like to know about it, and the circumstances under which it reduces to the laws with which we are familiar.

We frequently encounter references to "planes of vibration" which, frankly, don't mean very much to us. What is vibrating? What degrees of freedom has it? What directions are involved in the vibrations? What mathematical expression will describe this vibration? What numerical values are associated with the vibration? Movement of any kind in the material universe is always accompanied by fields of various sorts; what fields are associated with these vibrations?

We know of no experiment where particles have appeared without the absorption of an equivalent amount of energy, nor do we know of any means whereby particles can vanish without manifesting exactly equivalent energy. Surely, if anything the size of an ether ship could appear or disappear, there must be tremendous energies involved. Where, then lies this energy?

In your descriptions of the ether worlds there is no description of the precise organization of the basis substance to form the reality of those worlds. Unless our concepts of reality are very much at fault, SOME type of organization is necessary. We would like to know on what principles this is based.

The foregoing is based on an honest desire on our part to get to the bottom of this interesting subject, and is not intended to be in any way critical of the work which your group obviously have done on this matter. We would appreciate it very much if you could attempt answers to the above questions, and possibly many more which will occur to us from time to time. I sincerely hope that you will appreciate why this letter is being sent unofficially, since our terms of reference are rather specific as to the lines of investigation which we may follow.

Gentlemen,

I was very pleased to get your letter, but sorry that you were unable to get to Washington. However, I am most definitely looking forward to a visit with you whenever you can arrange it.

I was rather disappointed in George Lafleur. While he undoubtedly picked up some material from the boys top side during their earlier work, I am afraid he was given too much to wishful thinking. I let him have one of the coils for a while and he gave me quite a story about its performance, which I have good reason to doubt. This coil is NOT an antenna as everyone seems to consider it. I believe that the effects which Lafleur claimed are real all right but not through any virtue of the coil. Many of nature's phenomenae are possible of mental control; I can operate on a few myself.

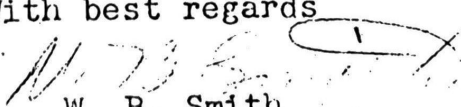
However, if you want to play with this coil I shall be glad to help in any way I can. I am enclosing a sketch of its construction and since you have seen one of the originals, duplication should not be too hard.

The main point is to find the frequencies at which it will "convert" ordinary radio energy into tensor energy. At these frequencies it is possible to send a kilowatt or more into the coil without it showing any tendency to get warm. Under these conditions a small but real tensor beam is being generated, and with which an EXPERT operator can accomplish a great deal. I can't tell you how to find the critical frequencies because each coil and ferrite core have different values, but trial and error will disclose them eventually. There are several for each unit.

With respect to coming events, Affa has given us quite a bit and it has all worked out in the right order but with a little more delay than he indicated. I would very much like to cross check with others regarding Affa and his group, and when we get together we may be able to work something out.

Returning to the coil, I am sure you can get a ferrite rod in New York. The size IS NOT critical, nor is the winding beyond the fact that it must be symmetrical. Of course the combination determines the critical frequencies at which conversion takes place. Even if you use rods as small as $\frac{1}{8}$ inch and wind with # 36 wire it should work at reasonable medium high frequencies. Please let me know how you make out.

Thanks for your good letter of the 7th, we were recently wondering about you and Murl and what was happening up there as far as Saucers were concerned as there isn't much to talk about going on down here. However, a few interesting things did take place, and one was that we got to talk to Williamson again after all this time and get a firsthand account of exactly what is it he is doing at this time.

You may or may not know that we didn't go along with many of the things which we knew Ric was doing and writing down there in South America. After talking with him at length, we must still admit that we don't quite go along with him on some of these new ventures of his. He seems to have quite a following however and perhaps it's all for the best.

We also got to meet again John McCoy of Texas whom we first met in Prescott when he and Ray Stanford came to visit us at our Arizona home. He and Williamson were in N.Y. on a tour they were taking of some of the country, while at the same time lecturing and getting more people interested in their work in S.A. His lecture in N.Y. was called; "The Lost World and the U.F.O.'s" and was introduced by Henry Mayday, the fellow who said he would try to get our former group in Arizona completely financed for the expeditions in S.A..(He never did).

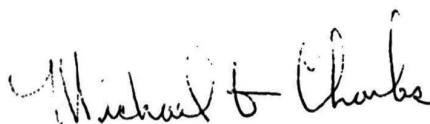

Glad to hear about this Mr. Stelk, and by the way if you ever get a hold of: "Door To Revelation" an autobiography by Pelley, let us know. We have been trying to get a copy for a long time now and their completely out of circulation, perhaps since 1938. So we would appreciate this very much.
