

letter of 31 Jan., 1961 - DRB letter to same F.B. Cote -

"DRB has not undertaken to investigate sightings of UFOs and is not associated with any projects which may have been reported in the press"

letter of 3 Feb. 1961 from W.B. Smith to F.B. Cote.

"We came to the conclusion that there was about a 90% probability that the objects were real and a 60% probability that they were extra-terrestrial. However, these conclusions are not official and are entirely those of the small group who worked with me in the analysis of the data. The project never had a really official status beyond the fact that a number of files were opened to accommodate the sighting reports and associated correspondence."

"Since the termination of the project in 1954, I have maintained a personal interest in the matter and have subsequently received a large number of sighting reports, but these have added only statistical confirmation to the conclusions already reached."

Copy of page 5408 of HANSARD, Vol. 108, No. 103, Dec. 4, 1963

contains questions (No. 1416 - Mr. Winch) re Project Magnet in the USA (Navy constellations) and Project Magnet in Canada. The answers are of interest, but are confusing as they imply that the Canadian project was similar to that of the U.S.
