

THE BORDERLAND SCIENCES RESEARCH ASSOCIATES

The BSRA is an association of persons interested in 'borderland' facts and happenings, i.e., in facts and events which 'orthodox' or official science cannot or will not investigate, such as the officially 'damned' facts which Charles Fort and his associates studied at great length, and in which the Fortean Society maintains an alert interest.

Examples of such subjects would be: the 'vortexes' of the West (where the laws of gravity seem distorted), mysterious appearances and disappearances of persons, phenomena of hypnosis, materialization, teleportation, telekinesis, apportionment, the psycho-kinetic (PK) effect, clairvoyance, clairaudience, and trance: effects of atomic fission on weather, the problem of underground races, the teachings and practice of HUNA, the physiological effect of carbon emanation ('Vitic'), the Morley-Martin experiments in abiogenesis, the experiments of Dr. C.W. Littlefield (effects of mind-action on microscopic crystals), the Koch treatment and other treatments for cancer and allied allergies, a great number of current etheric phenomena, and specifically at present, the origin and nature of the Ether Ships and other unknown aircraft now visiting our planet.

BSRA studies are characterized by the fact that the Associates are willing to employ any methods which will yield valuable information, whether they be acceptable to 'orthodox' science or not. A lengthy study has been made of the remarkable trance mediumship of Mark Probert and of the communications received by that means. The 'occult' of today is the science of tomorrow: it is simply knowledge not yet familiar to us. But the BSRA is not a cult or belief, and carries no propaganda, save for the impartial study of ALL facts by ALL useful methods.

The principal publications of the BSRA are: the ROUND ROBIN, which has been issued since 1946; and "Clips, Quotes, and Comments", a (more recent) bi-weekly (alternating weeks) bulletin, supplementary to ROUND ROBIN.

Bulletins and Releases are also sent out as the occasion demands.

BSR is operated as a public service, and expenses are met by donations and by a minimum charge for publications.
