

SUMMARY OF UFO NEWS FROM CAROL WHITE
INVESTIGATING THE HAMILTON AREA

August 29,1975--Ancaster

Craig Kohne called me regarding some lights which he had been seeing for the last six months. These lights had been observed on EVERY clear night. There were three lights which "flared up" at irregular intervals. Another light from the northwest would come down to meet one of the lights and one of the three would move off to the northwest again. All of the movements were very slow-slower than an aircraft

Due to the fact that these have been seen all the time on a regular basis I tend to feel that this is a natural phenomena and since I have yet to figure out what they are I am not sending this report in.

September--Hamilton

A lady who refused to tell me her name called to inform me that everynight she saw U.F.O.s. She said that at first they looked like ordinary stars but when she looked through her binoculars they turned all sorts of colours and got larger. I suggested to her that her binoculars were dirty at which point she more or less told me off. She plagued me with phonecalls several times every night for over a week but would not tell me where she lived, her name or allow me to at least go over to her place during one of these "sightings". Needless to say I did not report this incident and have more or less considered it a "nut" case.

December-- Hamilton

Greg and Sharon MacQueen both 27 years old noticed a bright light on December 14 during the afternoon. They thought it was the evening star at first but then it slowly started to move to the left. It then faded and flared brightly again-brighter than Venus. They continued observing it through a very old pair of field glasses and soon it could not be seen with the naked eye again. It took about 6-7 minutes to move the distance between the thumb and baby finger. Greg is a professor at McMaster University and they both were reasonable people.

I would have been much happier if this light had moved erratically or in some fashion so that I could have been sure that it was not a plane which could have turned and hence the light diminished. In any event I am keeping this report with me until more comes up.
