Thank you very much for the copy of the Report on Project Magnet. I was given a copy some years ago by Peter Millman, but perhaps I can pass on this extra copy to another interested person.

The file I was trying to locate at D.O.C. was a former D.O.T. file on Project Magnet which I know existed as I have seen official written evidence of this, and I know also that it was transferred to D.O.C. Now its existence is denied.

However, I have two questions with regard to UFO files which I hope you can answer for me.

First, the National Defence Records Management Section has stated, through the Directorate of History, that the UFO files of Air Defence Command pre-1965 were transferred to N.R.C. The only D.N.D. reports I have seen in your non-meteoritic files cover the period 1965 to 1968. Can you tell me whether N.R.C. has these A.D.C. files?

Secondly, there is a gap in your D.N.D. file serial numbers in 1967 (numbers 177 to 199 are not allocated). Can this gap be explained?

I will be grateful for your assistance.
