KUWAIT (UPI)—The first-ever flying saucer in Kuwait came without sound, was as big as a jumbo jet, cylindrical, with a huge dome and a flashing red light. After seven minutes in a Kuwaiti oil field, it took off without a trace, said seven Kuwait Oil Co. technicians, including one American, who claimed they saw it.

A close encounter with the arab kind

Technicians at a Kuwaiti oil field have reported a scientific first for the Arab world — the sighting of a flying saucer, complete with flashing red lights.

The sighting reportedly so unnerved the observers that work on the Persian Gulf nation's precious commodity came to a complete halt.

Some seven workers, including one American, said they saw the cylindrical object, said to be "larger than a jumbo jet," Friday afternoon.

According to the on-lookers, the UFO approached the oilfield, located 90 miles from the capital city of Kuwait, landed "without a sound" and took off again seven minutes later.

Whatever it was, the Kuwaitis say that telephone communications and oil pumping services were disrupted temporarily.

UFO VISITS KUWAIT OIL FIELD

IN NOVEMBER 1978 oil-rich Kuwait reported its first-ever flying saucer. Seven Kuwait Oil Company technicians, including one American, claim they saw it for seven minutes until it took off without leaving a trace behind.

The UFO was described as completely soundless, as big as a jumbo jet, cylindrical in shape with a huge dome and a flashing red light. It landed Friday, November 10, at Umm Alaiish, causing a temporary disruption of telecommunications and the operations of an oil pumping station about 250 yards from the landing site.

As soon as the UFO took off the oil pumping equipment started to function again. The witnesses said they were "frozen with horror" at what they saw and hesitated to approach the object.

If the report is true, said Kuwaiti Security Chief Brig. Gen. Mohammed al Hammad, it was a first for the Persian Gulf oil state.
