Thank you very much for sending me a copy of the book jacket and for the copy of the "Special proceedings on science policy" by the Senate of Canada. I bought a copy of your book when it was first published, and I have followed with interest your attempts to gain support for further investigation of UFO reports.

(One minor comment: my understanding of the Gallup Poll of 1966, as well as the report by Captain Ruppelt of Project Bluebook and the survey by the Condon Committee, was that about one out of ten people report UFO sightings. Thus, the figures usually estimate that 90% of UFO observers do not report their sightings to officials, rather than the figure of 99.5% which was cited in your statement. I do not have the figures at hand, so I cannot check on whether my memory is accurate.)

I'm gratified to learn that you are continuing your interest in investigation of UFO reports, and I hope your efforts lead to further support among agencies or groups within Canada.
