Dear Mr. Hoover:

I should like to call your attention to a case concerning the F.B.I.

There is a book written recently by the English publisher of Flying Saucers Have Landed by Mr. George Adamski of Palomar Terraces, Star Route, Valley Center, California. The English publisher's name is Mr. Waveney Girvan, and his book is called Flying Saucers and Common Sense. This book is published by the Citadel Press of 222 Fourth Avenue, New York 3, N. Y.

On pages 120 and 121 of Flying Saucers and Common Sense, it says, "On 17th December, 1953, George Adamski was visited by three F.B.I. agents who questioned him at some length on a radio interview which he gave on 7th December at Los Angeles. As a result of this broadcast a number of telephone calls had been made to their headquarters in Washington, D.C. Adamski was then warned to keep quiet and not to mention the government or any of its services. He was further warned that because of the broadcast a warrant for his arrest had been signed by the Attorney-General and that the next time a thing like this occurred he would be arrested."

This story sounds unbelievable and I am usually suspicious of anything that appears in a flying saucer book; nevertheless, I want the facts.

I should appreciate it very much if you will please answer the following questions for me:

1. Did three F.B.I. agents visit Mr. George Adamski and threaten him that he was to keep quiet and not to mention the government or any of its services hereafter?
2. Was Mr. Adamski warned that because of the broadcast a warrant for his arrest had been signed by the Attorney-General and that the next time a thing like this occurred he would be arrested?
3. If the story is false, does the F.B.I. plan on doing anything about it?
