

For verification may I call in heed consideration of the Secretary General, and the Chairman of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space the following documented facts:

On February 1966, upon my UFO Memorandum the late Secretary General U THANT assigned me--as member of the Secretariat Staff--to elaborate the first UN-UFO PROJECT. (Enclosure # 7.) This project with militarily analysed documentation, was presented on February 24, 1966, to his Chief of the Cabinet, C.V. Narasimhan. During our 3/4 hour conference on the planned establishment, he informed me that Thant's objective was regarding the U.N. Constitution, to submit a verified UFO report to the Security Council, referring its solution to the nations' security. "WE CALL YOU BACK SOON" sounded the farewell of the Assistant Secretary General. (Enclosure # 7.)

But, on the other side of this 'FAREWELL' TOKEN, time has revealed instead of the solution of the UFO problem--the succeeded cover ups, violations, narrasments and abuses within the United Nations. (Enclosure # 8.)

1. For my Memorandum and UN-UFO PROJECT, the L.B. Johnson Administration on the spot acted and demanded MY IMMEDIATE REMOVAL from the Secretariat, placing me arbitrary and illegally on the SECURITY RISK. (Enclosure # 9.)
2. My Project was urgently replaced for the U.N. by the USAF sponsored Colorado University UFO Study, known as the Condon Report. (Encl. # 8.)
3. Secretary General U Thant was constrained to withdraw his statements that "...he considers UFOs the most important problem facing the UN next to the war in Vietnam." (Enclosure # 9.)--and his Chief of Cabinet childishly explained to the public that "...the Secretary General's interest in the subject is purely academic and personal..." (Enclosure # 11.)
4. To wipe out all the traces of U Thant's actions in 1966, ALL THE DOCUMENTATIONS WERE OBLITERATED according to the Outer Space Committee's Secretary Mr. Marvin Robinson: "SINCE THEY WERE NOT SOLICITED". (?) (See Encl. # 11!) In the same letter that "...the Committee has never had the item of UFOs on its agenda and therefore this subject has never been discussed by the Committee or any of its subsidiary bodies..."--regarding the Chairman of the Committee Dr. Kurt Waldheim's letter, is FALSE, UNTRUE, and WILFUL MISREPRESENTATION to the public. (Enclosure # 13.)

It is remarkable that H.E. Peter Jankovitsch, Ambassador of Austria, Chairman of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space has never granted to our Network acknowledgement of our Memorandum and its Dossiers, delivered on February 3, 1988, personally to the Austrian U.N. Mission. We therefore respectfully request the Secretary General to communicate with us:

1. Did H.E. Peter Jankovitsch referred to Him the Memo and the Dossiers?
2. His definite viewpoint on the two Mighty Powers (USA and USSR) military preparation of mutual space defense against extraterrestrial alien forces, and HIS CONSIDERED ACTION TO PREVENT IN TIME HUMANITY'S SPACE WAR SUICIDE. (Consult Enclosures 2, 3, 4, 5.)
