You mentioned Richzeke before - now his name rings a bell. ^{Foramen} ~~He~~ gave it to me. His name was not mentioned by Budge.

If you see him could you put his association with Smith in context. ① Did he work with the Canadian govt.? ② Did he work on the anti-gravity experiments? ③ Did he go to see Mrs. Swan (many of Smith's closer associates travelled to Maine with Smith) ④ Most importantly find out if he knows who AFIA is? ⑤ Did he correspond with Smith? ⑥ Does he have any issues of "Topside"?

If he was around Smith he must have at least one weird story such as the enclosure from Duplantier found in my files.

There is a lot of material on the piece hauled from the St. Lawrence. Actzehner seems to be the only one left around who still claims to have a piece. I will send along some material on it.

If Pratt sends a copy of his manuscript, I will pay you the costs to reproduce and send me a copy. Bob covered the 1975 flap here and ~~got~~ can get to the bottom of the story if he believes. He seemed to be very conservative on documents in the last couple letters I got from him.

I have some more letters related to Fitch. Got them from Greenwood. Maybe he has Fitch's files. There is no real connection. Knowles lived near Mrs. Swan and alerted the Navy Intelligence. As a member of the board of NICAP, Smith learned of Swan probably thru Keyhoe. Because Swan is also in contact with AFFA, Smith probably ran to see her.

Fitch did not know about Swan but pursued the 1952 piece (which Stokes wrote extensively about in FATE). The connections were the same as with Mrs. Swan. Knowles-Smith - Lundell.

Fitch is famous for his interview by phone with Smith where Smith states he gave the 52 piece back to a "small group" much higher than the AIR Force.

Fitch writes to Knowles and Smith trying to uncover who the small group was. Smith does not budge. He states "in official hands."

Later in the intro to "Hollow Earth" a "conversation" with Smith is referred to where Smith again refers to a small group that controls the hardware. This conversation again was credited to Fitch although this is not certain.

Admiral Knowles Dole^{n't} think had any clearance on these matters. He was simply shown the 52 piece. Fitch Oguess thought he had an inside track.

I tried to contact Fitch ten years back without success.

I have sent Bob's ^{9th} actual letter in reference to his book to Stevens. I imagine he will pass it to you.

If MS-12 (as described by the FSM documents) are for real why are they not aware of the AZTEC and Paradise Valley crashes. Also they don't have Bush as MS-1. Thirdly your date for the Roswell crash is different than there's. (Pull quickly listen to Friedman's estimation of you don't imagine

- you have also used a sanitized copy of the Belling AFB document, but you used the clean copy as well P 304 vs. 625. Docs have received both copies. Any idea why Ufolgiasts would find it necessary to sanitize documents.

Dr. L. Tago Wilson - NRC, now chancellor of York University if still alive. (magnetic expert, rocks, fields, etc.)

Dr. George Garland - NRC, now at University of Toronto. (gravitational expert)

Dr. James Watt - physicist from D.R.B., now at University of

John H. Thompson - communications expert, Dept of Transport - Canadian govt. has told me there are 150 people in the civil service with this name so am having some trouble tracking these people down.

From 1956 to 1962 (Willet's death)

Dr. L. Bridge - worked at Defense Research Board from 1952-1962. Worked with Willet from 5 on. quite close - a couple meeting a week at least. This is who I interviewed. Worked on the anti-gravity experiments with success. Smith supervised

Paul Gilchrist - died in the mid 70s
I corresponded with his wife. He apparently was
quite brilliant but had a "nervous state"
according to Budge.

"Buck" Buchanan - formerly with the R.C.M.P.
was involved in the anti-gravity experiments near
W. Apparently has cancer.

Macdonald - still have no first name
Some assistance from Budge to give this name as
Macdonald is high up in D.C.T. with satellites
etc.

The usual membership in the Ottawa New
Science club was 22-24, as high as 56. The
few above were the scientific line assistants to
Smith in the club. Budge told me at times
however, he felt he was only a lab assistant.
Smith would tell him "Build this" "weld that
coil."

Unfortunately if Budge was told little of
the gov't work, few others would know.

As to the Swan case. If you have the
Project Aquarius documents released by Moore
you will find a Project Sigma. This fits the
Swan case. First as per the Enclosure TOP SECRET
Project. According to Miss Smith (I am trying to get
written confirmation on this) AFFA who Smith was
in contact with was to land at Suffield. AFFA wanted
a guarantee he would be allowed to land. The
RCMP and "government?" said yes. Then Smith
AFFA requested a guarantee he would be allowed
to take off once the contact was finished. After the
R.C.M.P. agreed. After a long meeting the "government?"
(probably Defense Research Board People) they stated

they could not guarantee it. Therefore JFFS called the whole thing off. The government tells the truth "nothing ever happened."

Smith found out (we don't have this because yet) about Mrs. Swan this "technical" knowledge who was a good friend of Smith's. The FBI got involved and I am about to get that file (1954). Smith and U.S. Navy Intelligence were in contact till 1959 and the "Psyche" Incident.

Put the Suffield landing with JFFA and the CIA contact with JFFA and you have what is described as Project Sigma.

T. Zechel has some good interview material with Art Finkel (one of the participants in this case and also involved in the 1952 piece that came to Canada). Problem is finding Zechel. Eric Greenwood don't know where he is. I've more on the Swan case if you are still interested. It has been written up a couple times. nobody has really gone after it.

You will also note in the TOP SECRET Project Document article that there was another committee. I have recently written to Mr. Hellyer to push for records, as there were no TOP SECRET committees dealing with C.F.S. We could have another MS-12. Topside ~~public~~ ^{public} admits spoke of W.B. Smith as being on this committee. This is questionable tho' as I don't think they know about this first hand either.

She told everyone who came that she had burned them. Then she stated the book was started - nothing was ever missing and to her the intent was clear.

This story of the records is one I have never pushed her to answer as who knows who to trust. I think Bray got some or all. I have asked him in my last letter to clarify this point.

It's been a lot of years, and I have finally attempted to again get Mrs. Smith to talk. She told me a lot in I believe 78 face to face, but the whole thing is a bit hazy. The stories above are a rough sketch of what she claimed at that time.
