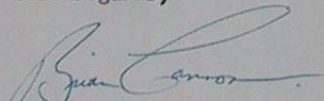
Just a note to let you know that PROJECT MAGNET arrived in good condition. I found it most interesting; Mr. Smith had definite ideas on the subject.
