In reference to your letter of October 9th, 1978, I feel that our original proposal is still unclear.

- a) Both Robert & I DO NOT wish to become Canada's 'authorities' on UFO's.
- b) We are not attempting to become the national organization - nor do we wish to brush aside the studies of such researchers as; Musgrave, McKay, Hoville, Project SUM, or yourself.

However, I will state here that our prime goal is; To collect and properly file on computer tapes (investigations as well) as many UFO reports as possible from CANADA. Our sources are; the N.R.C., Canadian Press Clipping Service, & correspondents from Canada (and we do have correspondents in the Martimes & in some of the western provinces). To put it in a nut shell - I would like to establish a library for Canadian UFO reports - an idea discussed with Dr. Hynek, one of which he seemed to favor.

All I am asking of Canadian researchers is to assist us in the collection of reports which ~~XXXX~~ in the future our library would assist them. *

In reference to your remarks on UFO CANADA, I must point out that the core of my information from Canada comes from the CANADIAN UFO REPORT (see UFOs & the Canadian Government - Kanon, Vol. 3 no.6) which was confirmed by other sources. It is important to remember that there has NEVER been a proper version of past Canadian research. For this reason, I am looking forward to your book (which I hope will for once and all properly present a history of past UFO studies in Canada.

Myself, nor UFO CANADA is not perfect and both have faults. However, if you take a moment a really look through UFO CANADA, From no.1 to the present issues, the progression towards an objective and canadian minded publication is clearly unfolding.
