Dear Sirs:-

In reply to your letter, the following personal information is forwarded for your files.

I am a Lieutenant Commander in the Royal Canadian Navy and have been in the service for 14 years. For my first six years in the service I was a pilot and flew a dozen different types of aircraft.

My special interests is searching for truth regarding life, the nature of the universe, and God. Toward this end I am making a study of U.F.O.'s ancient history, world religions, astronomy and metaphysics.

As for "formal" education, I completed high school and obtained junior matriculation standing. I am a member of the National Geographic Society and also of the Royal Astronomical Society of Canada.

I have been studying the U.F.O. problem since June 1947 when they came to public attention. I own many U.F.O. books, have an extensive collection of clippings etc., in a scrap book, have maintained correspondence with several individuals and organizations particularly concerned with U.F.O.'s and have subscribed to the British publication Flying Saucer Review for two years.

After approximately three years of study, it became obvious to me that the U.F.O.'s are interplanetary. Recently, I have become convinced that at least some U.F.O.'s are not only interplanetary, but come from across the "Cosmic Barrier", in other words, are ethereal.

My opinion goes even beyond the above statement, to some considerable extent, but I will not commit myself further at this point.

There is no doubt that the beings in the U.F.O.'s are here to help us, guide us, and teach us.
