Dear Mayor Shiotani:

The 21st century, the "ERA OF OUTER SPACE", will be a new "RENAISSANCE" to stimulate the dream of human beings towards intellectual adventures. I was surprised to hear that the International Space and UFO Symposium - kind of meeting that has never been held in Japanese History - will take place in Hakui City, Ishikawa Prefecture. In fact, I have two reasons why I am interested in this Symposium:

First of all, I told a magazine this past January that, as an underdeveloped country with regards to the UFO problem, Japan had to take into account what should be done about the UFO question, and that we had to spend more time on these matters. In addition, I told that someone had to solve the UFO problem with far reaching vision at the same time. Secondly, I believe that it is a reasonable time to take the UFO problem seriously as a reality.

In this symposium, top-level UFO researchers and astronauts from the Soviet Union and the United States will get together to discuss the subject and deliver speeches. I hope that this Symposium will contribute to peace on Earth from the point of view of outer space, and take the first step toward the international cooperation in the field of UFOs.

From the point of view of "people" in outer space, all human beings on Earth are the same people, regardless of whether they are American, Russian, Japanese, or whoever.

We need to have the same recognition of this fact in the future of the 21st century. I have the greatest expectation from the people of Ishikawa Prefecture, who are watching the Earth and looking up to outer space with a wide point of
