

SITUATION RED, THE UFO SIEGE, Leonard Stringfield (1977, 244 pages)

Relates the author's experiences in collecting sighting reports for the Air Force in the 1950s; recounts many of the cases he has investigated personally, including the concentration of sightings that formed, for the author, the "siege" of 1973, all in the context of a broad knowledge of the many aspects of the UFO phenomenon. The last part of the book describes in detail the apparent abduction and return in Jan., 1976 of the three Kentucky women.

ANATOMY OF A PHENOMENON: Unidentified Flying Objects in Space--A Scientific Appraisal, by Jacques Vallee (1965, 210 pages)

36 Dr. Vallee discusses in detail unsolved cases occurring between 1947 and 1964, a period of high activity. He examines the reactions of various groups and methods of investigation, proposes a system of classification and reviews several theories advanced to explain UFOs.

CHALLENGE TO SCIENCE: The UFO Enigma, by Jacques and Janine Vallee (1966, 328 pages)

37 A discussion of the global and novel nature of the UFO phenomenon, of sightings from the U.S. Air Force files and from European and other private sources with an analysis of the topographic and temporal patterns of the sightings as well as the reported physical characteristics of the objects described. The authors conclude with an evaluation of the current interpretations of the origin of the phenomenon and some predictions as to what it may hold in store for mankind.

THE INVISIBLE COLLEGE, by Jacques Vallee (1975, 216 pages)

A possible connection among the psychic components of some UFO reports, "extra-terrestrial" communications and religious revelations is presented and discussed, along with aspects of UFO research and the author's theory that UFOs are part of a control system.

MESSENGERS OF DECEPTION, by Jacques Vallee. 1979 (243 pages)

Dr. Vallee considers the belief in UFOs to be more important than the phenomenon itself, especially the expectation of the imminent arrival of beings from outer space, which he says is having a profound effect on our society. He presents the results of his studies of a number of cults, followed by disclosures from a "Major Murphy" and others about covert techniques of manipulating minds, and concludes that people themselves are manipulating the belief in UFOs in order to bring about fundamental changes in society--possibly another age of irrationality. Potential implications of some incidents of cattle mutilation are discussed also.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE 1976 C.U.F.O.S. CONFERENCE (Nancy Dornbos, Ed.) (1976, 320 pages)

The complete text of 35 papers that range from general discussions of the phenomenon to highly technical reports about possible methods of propulsion to analyses of spatial and temporal distribution of UFO sightings, this also includes subsets of reports involving such features as animal reactions to UFOs, abduction of witnesses, features of reported humanoid encounters and physical traces found after sightings.
