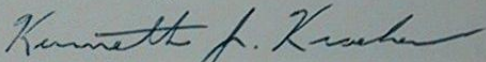


As to joining forces with UFO Research Centre: Ontario, we have requested cooperation from the Centre several times and unfortunately they refuse to exchange reports with us. We have achieved this type of cooperation with several other groups in Canada and the U.S. however. At the present time, the only correspondence with the Centre is the trading of publications and the occasional letter. I hope this situation will be rectified in the near future.

I also agree to your views concerning the fact that many groups are "fragments" of the whole field of UFO research, the failure to let outsiders and the general public know about their research findings and important UFO sightings. The type of group wishing not to tell the public about UFO sightings or research findings they come across can be detected by the kind of material covered in their newsletters. Fortunately, groups are being encouraged today to send their material into the larger UFO publications where the majority of UFOlogists and UFO organizations may follow up on aspects which interest them.
