1. We received your 30 December 1980 request for data on Project "Blue Room" from the HQ FTD/DADF on 9 January 1981.
2. We do not have records of Project "Blue Room" at this headquarters.
3. The AF Form 1350 you provided helped us identify the organization at Wright-Patterson that was apparently responsible for "Blue Room". We reviewed the inventory of records that were retired by the organization but we found no mention of the project.
4. We also asked our historians to conduct a search of the records in the Archives hoping to at least find a monograph that contains the start and finish of the project. Unfortunately the official histories do not show the Code word "Blue Room".
5. We must conclude that records of the project were destroyed.

Dear Mr. Graham:

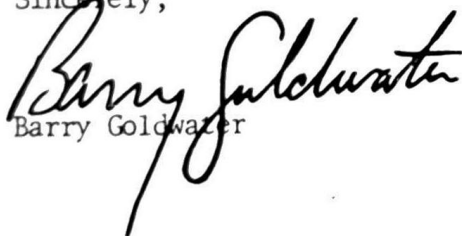
