AP.: Were you a military officer do not you?

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Evidences of US censorship on constructive subjects regarding the UFOs global problem:

1/ On June 23, 1966, I delivered at the United Nations Secretariat to the Associated Press representative ICUFON Press Release on our International Space Security Pact - Space Law. (Consult Blue Memorandum p.105.)

One of the office editor informed me that on account of my proposal to Sec. Gen. U Thant on February 1966, any release from us is prohibited for the wire service.

2/ On October 11, 1978, United Nations AP correspondent Mr. William N. Oatis released a media item on our Green Memorandum filed and submitted to all the delegates of the United Nations.

The copy of the news item published in the Blue Memorandum page 24 was suppressed by the AP Central Office (50 Rockefeller Plaza, NYC.) and never published to the AP news paper subscribers. We controlled in New York City and with Pennsylvania's papers.
