This will acknowledge your letter of 13 November 1972.

I am sorry to have taken so long in replying but I wanted to have an opportunity to see the book Harmonic 695 before writing you. Unfortunately, the book has been on loan and it was necessary to wait for some time before it became available.

As I am sure you realize, evaluating a theory such as that advanced in the book is not a simple matter. To do this in a meaningful way would require the concentrated efforts of experts in a number of related fields, including, as you indicated in an earlier letter, the physics of nuclear explosions. This field lies entirely outside the range of activities undertaken by the National Research Council.

Under the circumstances I can only confirm the reply made to you in my earlier letter. The limited resources of the National Research Council prevent it from undertaking in any meaningful way the investigation you have requested.
