Dear Mr. Bray:

I am enclosing copies of correspondence exchanged with
Dr. Millman of the National Research Council.

I have taken the liberty of informing him that possibly
you would be in touch with him regarding the UFO files
in their possession. Could I prevail upon you to dis-
cuss the matter further with Dr. Millman and look at
the files mentioned in my letter to Mr. Cadieux? I
would very much like to visit Ottawa in the near future
for this purpose however I would like to have some idea
exactly what these files contain. I sure you are aware
that what is in the files and what the investigation
actually uncovered could be two entirely different things.

I was very disappointed over recent information regarding
the problems at the U. of Colorado. It is disturbing to
hear of Dr. Condon's feelings but on the other hand it
is good to know some of the project scientists were will-
ing to speak up against his apparent negative approach.
I had hoped the NRC program would provide an intensive
scientific investigation in this country despite Dr.
Rettie's recent comments, however my hopes are slowly
dwindling.

If you would be willing to assist us with the above request
I would be most grateful. Please let me know how you make
out and if possible, secure photocopies of the Michalak
and Charleswood, Man. files. Your book was excellent and
in the next issue (Vol. I, No. IV) we will have a writeup
on it with a good recommendation.
