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SUMMARY OF RESULTS

An unidentified aerial object,
which was received from a representative
of the Department of Transport, Ottawa,
has been examined by X-ray diffraction and
spectrographic techniques. The irregularly-
shaped, metallic object was identified as
austenitic high-manganese steel. It is almost
certain to have been of terrestrial rather than
of meteoric origin.

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
