

THE MYSTERY OF THE GHOST ROCKETS, Loren Gross. Fremont, CA: privately printed, 1974. (54 pages)

✓ A description of mysterious objects seen primarily over Scandinavia in 1946-47 and then over the rest of Europe.

THE UFO WAVE OF 1896, Loren Gross. Fremont, CA: privately printed, 1974. (34 pages)

✓ Sightings of an unknown "fireship" as reflected by accounts in California newspapers.

THE UFO EXPERIENCE, J. Allen Hynek. Chicago: Henry Regnery Company, 1972. (270 pages)

✓ In this classic introduction to the subject of UFOs, Dr. Hynek indicates the overwhelming volume of evidence which serves as the raw data for a scientific examination of the subject, states his criteria for evaluating the evidence, and explains his system of classifying UFO reports. He gives examples of each type, as well as examples of misidentifications of known phenomena. He discusses his experience as astronomy consultant to the Air Force's Project Blue Book, the unwarranted conclusions of the Condon Committee's investigation, and general and scientific attitudes on this subject.

THE HYNEK REPORT ON UFOs, J. Allen Hynek. New York: Dell Publishing Co., December, 1977. (Orders accepted in November)

✓ The information of the U.S.A.F. Project Blue Book file, released as 94 reels of microfilm, forms the basis for this book. The author, who was consultant to Project Blue Book during its entire existence, has taken this opportunity to report on the "behind the scenes" aspects of the project and to demonstrate, by the analysis of the sighting reports, most of which were never made public, that the Air Force did its best to cover up the UFO phenomenon by playing down the subject.

REPRODUCTIONS OF DOCUMENTS

UNIDENTIFIED AERIAL OBJECTS--PROJECT "SIGN" (1949, 46 pages)

✓ The first comprehensive report prepared by the Air Technical Intelligence Center (ATIC), this is a descriptive and analytical account of the U.S. Air Force study of UFOs. Originally classified "SECRET," it has been declassified but not officially released.

PROJECT "SAUCER" (1949, 22 pages)

✓ This is the press release issued by the USAF in response to demands for details of Project SIGN. It summarizes the sightings of the period 1947-1949, and includes discussions of the Arnold, Mantell, Chiles-Whitted and Gorman sightings, as well as astronomical, balloon and hoax reports.

PROJECT MAGNET REPORT and PROJECT SECOND STOREY (1950, 47 pages)

✓ The Second Storey Committee was sponsored by the Canadian Defense Research Board to collect, catalog and correlate data on UFO sightings. The report includes guidelines for reporting UFOs, lists of normal phenomena commonly mistaken for UFOs, sighting report forms, formulae for weighing sighting reports, sighting analysis charts, and summary of reports analyzed in 1952. The Project MAGNET committee utilized this report in making its study of the saucer phenomena and reaching its conclusion of the real existence of extraterrestrial vehicles.

REPORT OF MEETINGS OF SCIENTIFIC ADVISORY PANEL ON UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS CONVENED BY OFFICE OF SCIENTIFIC INTELLIGENCE, CIA (1953, 42 pages) [Robertson Report]
