Dear Sir:

You will recall my letter of 16 January 1972 on the subject of UFOs. You were kind enough to forward a copy to Mr. Arkady Leokum, author of the "Tell Me Why" column. You even published a short editorial on the matter on 24 January.

Mr. Leokum responded to my letter on 11 February, with a copy to you. I believe that in so far as your file is concerned, the matter ended at that point. In fact, however, subsequent correspondence has taken place, and I want you to have copies in order that you may be brought up to date on this matter. As I maintain that the public has been seriously misinformed on the subject of UFOs for twenty five years, my main activity in this field is to attempt to remedy this by presenting facts of which the public is generally unaware, so that eventually a properly-conducted scientific study may be brought about through public demand.
