Dear Mr. Rideout,

I read your letter of October 23 with appreciation and some amusement. It is quite apparent that my comments on time as a field function did not ring a bell. I am well aware that regarding time as a variable places modern science in the untenable position of trying to lift itself by its bootstraps; but I can only say that these are not my ideas but originate with those to whom our science resembles medieval superstition. I do not understand them fully and I have much to learn, but I have mastered a few basic principles and of these I am sure.

Time as a field function is NOT the same function as registered by our clocks, which record the changing entropy of a system, but is the function which makes this happen.

There is only ONE reality in our universe, and that is the concept of SPIN, and from this derive twelve dimensions. Twelve dimensions are necessary and sufficient to express our universe in its entirety.

Dimensions must include as well as their vector direction, the component of reality in that direction for without the reality there would be no dimension.

Dimensions are arranged in four fabrics of three each, linked by a "quadrature concept". This is the concept that Relativity strives for by introducing $\sqrt{-1}$ between the space and time axis.

The concept of "force" is a fiction which we invented to stultify our thinking. It is merely a cover-up for our lack of understanding of the interaction of reality.

The foregoing will probably sound most sacreligious to the ears of orthodoxy, but I don't mind in the least if these ideas are not immediately subscribed to. Science has a long and lurid history of reluctance to accept ideas which subsequently proved to be of great value.

We are progressing quite well in our gravity research and ran our unit for the first time on Oct. 26. The effect was measured on a precision chemical balance, when a brass weight increased from 24.4623 grams to 24.4628 grams when the active material (1 cubic inch of aluminum) was 10 inches directly under the weight. Needless to say we have much yet to do and as soon as we have some relationships established we will prepare a suitable paper, a copy of which I shall send to you if you are interested.

Meanwhile, don't be upset about the above unorthodox ideas; they either click or don't click, and I am quite satisfied that we will all come to them sooner or later.

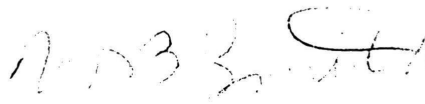
Dear Mr. Minifie,

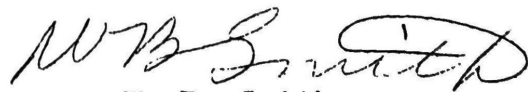
I would suggest that you make up a few and play with them to find out their characteristics. It is possible that you may be directed into its possibilities.

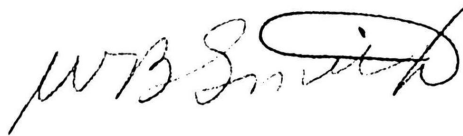

Your name and address was given to me by our mutual friend Dave Middleton, Tijeras, New Mexico, with the suggestion that I write to you.

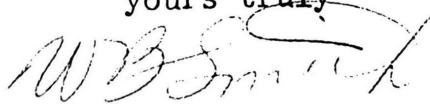

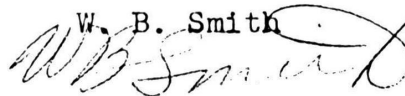

Dear Mr. Stewart, Many thanks for your long and informative letter, and the pictures. I can see that you are quite well equipped, and with a little patience should get some results.

I have taken the liberty of giving your name and address to TELONIC RESEARCH CENTER, Prescott, Arizona, who have set up quite an establishment to study the saucer problem. They may possibly get in touch with you with some aspect with which you could help, such as triangulation to obtain distance and size of some object.

Leonard Cramp's book is very good and much to the point, and I think is correct as far as it goes. He does not however, deal with the problem of gravity, but merely states that the saucer people must have a method of 'overcoming' gravity. From our own studies we think that this in the right direction but only a first step. The saucer people no doubt have a technology as far ahead of ours, as ours is ahead of the technology of the middle ages. What we should do as back up, take a good look in proper perspective, and take another run at it, but not over the same path! I do have the key information now but may not disseminate it yet. But I do know that any sincere attempt to find out will get right answers.

With respect to your precise position I am sure that you can get it from any of the Government offices in Vancouver. Just start at any one of them and some ten calls later you should connect with the right party. If you have any trouble just send me a road map with the spot marked on it and I shall figure out the Lats and Longs.

I can tell you something about the UFO people. They are of the same basic human stock as we. They have been civilized for a very long time. Cosmic Law requires that each race work out its own destiny, provided that it does not menace others. We are a menace, therefore we must be "dealt with", but the dealings will be "Acts of God" and our own fanaglings, or so they will seem to us. The saucer people stand ready to help and teach us as soon as we are ready. I cannot "prove" these statements yet but I know them to be true and have reason to believe that this will be common knowledge before long.

Dear David,

I am much interested in your activities, particularly with respect to the light modulated systems. I think that the tubes you have for the photoelectric work are as good as any and a fair representation. Please let me know about your experimental efforts.

With regard to the ferrite cores, I can't tell you very much beyond that which you already know. The formula which I gave you is based on the fact that ALL fields become established through Hertzian waves, and although we usually consider that fields contain energy, they really are only indicators of the RELATIVE energy level existing with reference to the space or material about which the field is to be found. When electrons are accelerated their relative energy levels are changed, and the indicators of this condition move into position as Hertzian waves. The fields within ferrite are due to changing energy levels of atoms with singular spins. These are reoriented as a result and in response to, the field(indicators) of the accelerated electrons in the wire. This means that the singular spins are rotated, which in turn produce more fields (indicators) which in turn induce further rotation. The net result of all this is that a sequence of spin re-alignments takes place within the ferrite which moves through the ferrite with a velocity equal to the velocity of light in free space, divided by the square root of the product of the effective permeability and dielectric constant. These last two quantities are not quite what we have been taught but our ideas are close enough to be useful. Now, the wave progressing through the ferrite must travel at the same velocity as the inducing wave in the surrounding wire, hence the formula. However, as the singular spins are rotated into new positions they obey perfectly normal vectorial laws, in three space and three field dimensions, and in so doing generate doughnut-shaped waves which comprise of closed electric, closed magnetic and closed but linked tempic fields. They are literally pushed out the far end of the ferrite core and sent merrily on their way. Since they involve extremely small mass they are easily directed, and since their rate of assimilation can be exactly the same as the rate of generation, (within a region having substantially the same tempic field) they can be tuned in by any receiver which has a closed circuit input. I hope this explanation is adequate.

With respect to the cores which you have, I would suggest that you use many turns of smaller wire as the relative velocity within should be of the order of 0.01

Some time ago we tried radio contact with the saucer people on 19,940 kc, but without much luck. Apparently they could hear us sweeping by their receiver setting, and we could hear a powerful station sweeping erratically across 19,940 but we couldn't tune it in. They said that it was due to the unstable nature of the earth's tempic field. If this is the case, then the doughnut waves should be the clear thing for communicating with them. They say that is what they use.

I havn't yet been able to check on the 10.8 mc. but expect to do so shortly. I am in charge of all the monitoring service in Canada so it shouldn't be too hard to get some of the boys to have a listen.

You may recall a report about 8 months ago about a saucer crash landing in Heligoland, and taken by the Norwegians. Affa says that is one of his ships and it is possible that the British may eventually have got their hands on it. I think that there are several in earth peoples hands, but I am afraid that they won't learn much about them from inspection; about as much as a Hotentot would learn about one of our aircraft. One must go to kindergarten before one goes to college.

As far as Canada is concerned, they have no program regarding UFO's now, except to sit tight and see what happens. AVRO's project is simply a circular airfoil craft, and that job in LOOK was just a designer's dream, probably after a hard night.

With reference to employment in Canada, I am not too sure of the conditions but I do know that only Canadians work in the civil service, although naturalization is a simple process. However, I shall try to gather together some bulletins and send them to you, which will give you facts.

I have available a Tapewriter tape machine which runs at slow speed, I think $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches per second. If you wish I shall prepare a tape on what I know about this time field business, and send it along. I imagine that Williamson might also be interested.

I am rebuilding my gravimeter, hoping to gain beter instrument stability, for the purpose of checking for time scale changes. One of our group Dr. D.F.Stedman has built a comparison spectrograph with recorder, for the same purpose. His idea is that the angle of diffraction in prisms and gratings will alter with time field changes. I feel that since gravity is directly a time field phenomenon. the gravimeter should show it. I also propose a direct measurement of the time taken for a pulse to travel a certain distance. If you are interested in this aspect I shall tell you more later.

Dear Mr. Innes,

Many thanks for your letter, enclosures, and the records which just arrived. I haven't yet had a chance to go through the records but hope to do so in the very near future. Yes, I agree that it is a big job to convince people from other planets that we are not all pugnacious and bloodthirsty, and that there are at least a few of us who want and are willing to work towards, a better day when we can all live together in full accordance with the Divine Plan.

If you have a chance to ask any direct questions of your contacts I would suggest the following;

"When you look at another planet in the general direction of the sun, does it appear to be closer to or farther away from the sun than it really is?"

"What scale of numbers do you use? 1,2,3,4,5,6,7, 8,9,10."

"When you compare the distance around a circle to the distance directly across it, what value do you get?"

"If you have day and night on your planet, and seasons of the year, how many of your days go to make up one of your years?"

"How many moons has your planet? And how many times each day do they cross the sky or how many days does it take between successive appearances?"

"When did your race come to your planet, and from where?"

"Do you people die? and if so, are your dead still in communication with your living?"

"When you look at the sun when it is quite near to your horizon, how much bigger than normal does it seem to be?"

If you could get some definite answers to the above it would throw a great deal of light on the identity of the communicators. There are certain things which have been passed to me and which I have checked and found to be correct, and which I have reason to believe are known to very few if any other earth people. From this data, if I can get straight answers to the above questions I may be in a position to help these people, and our own race, more than can be appreciated at the present time.

I believe that there is something going to happen in the not too distant future and I am trying to figure it all out from the rather sketchy data which I have been able to gather. Many thanks for your very valuable help and encouragement.

Dear Mr. Innes;

Many thanks for your letter and enclosure of May 15th. I was very pleased to hear from you again.

Please assure the medium on my behalf that I am not in any way questioning his integrity. I have had sufficient experience in psychic matters to realize that a medium is merely what the name implies, a go-between instrument. My comments were directed at the source of the messages, since it is apparent that language, and in particular, English, is quite foreign to those people. When people are used to communicating by direct thought processes, they can and do transmit precisely and exactly what they mean. But we who must use language can transmit only an approximation of what we really mean, and have learned to be satisfied with this. The telepathic people when they try to talk to us must make use of the language of the medium, which they must find exasperatingly inadequate, and consequently they keep saying the same things over and over again with slightly different words striving to convey their exact meaning, and probably not realizing what a pretty near hopeless job it is.

There are several groups of people who have managed contact with extra-terrestrials, and I am trying to piece together the identity and purpose of these various groups. Therefore I would appreciate it greatly if your contacts could communicate with the group on the moon as I am sure that group has the answers to many of the problems. At least they can land on earth and take off again. Affa is one of the leaders.

Dear Mr. Innes,

I wish to thank you very much for your great courtesey in sending me the many records of the sittings, of which I will take the best of care and return them to you shortly.

I have not yet completed my analysis but it does appear that the communicators need quite a bit of instruction as to conditions at this end of the circuit. You have probably noticed also the large amount of wordage used to convey a meaning. This is characteristic of communications from a race who use thought processes entirely among themselves. Thoughts are in themselves precise, and therefore when working through a medium they continually strive for the same degree of precision, even though they do not have available in the medium's vocabulary sufficient words of precise meaning to do the job.

I would suggest that sometime, when it is convenient, to insist with Areneshere on precise data, such as their scale of numbers, divisions of time, population numbers, names of chemical elements, precise description of their dwellings.

There is an object in this type of precision, as apparently they are having difficulty with our planet when they come near. Other space groups have had this same trouble, but it can be overcome as it is due to a condition of electric, magnetic and time fields. If the Mars people will just stop throwing themselves at a solid wall and realize that undeveloped as we are we can still help them if they will be precise with us. I think it is up to them to establish communication with us which is suitable to the problems of this world.

Dear Harry,

Thanks a lot for your two recent letters. They caught up on me before I had a chance to answer them. I was very much intrigued by the Dick Miller story. Points in it check very well with data which I have received from other sources, which I am sure neither Mr. Miller or any in your group know anything about.

There is one point which I think we all should bear in mind at all times when assessing these communications. I am convinced that the majority of them are genuine, but subject to a fundamental lack of precision in semantics. By this I mean that most of the people from other worlds use direct thought communication, which in itself is quite precise, but when they have anything to do with us they must work through a language. Consequently, although they appear to have a pretty good knowledge of the language, close examination brings out the fact that they frequently have pretty weird ideas about the meanings of some of our words. For example; one group with whom I was conversing used words entirely in their literary sense. We were discussing mathematics, I asked about their number scale which was 10 like ours, since they also have 10 fingers. I asked the difference between seven and three, and was told that there was no difference since they were both numbers! I asked when one subtracted three from seven how much was left and was told, nothing, since when one subtracts it is all gone! Further questioning brought forth the fact that their mathematics is operational and not equivalent as ours is. But this goes to show how careful one must be with the values of words.

I noticed several places in Dick Miller's story where words have rather obviously been carelessly used. Of course, I do not know where in the circuit the distortion entered but I strongly suspected the space people in their use of an alien means of communication. I refer particularly to the reference to cosmic rays. I do not think that was what was meant at all, but that the earth is moving into a region where strong electric, magnetic and time fields exist. A purely secondary consequence would be an apparent increase in cosmic ray count.

I was much interested in the photo cell and light beam experiment, and if I can find time I propose to play with it. It is a straight forward circuit and I should have no trouble with it. If I can get around to it and get anything interesting I shall let you know. However, from what I know of these people's technology I don't think any circuit is immune and I am quite sure that they can climb onto any circuit we have.

I am very interested in the book you mentioned and if a copy is still available I would like it. If available let me know the amount and I will send it along.

One thing which I would like to check thoroughly is the identity of all the various space people, where they are from and some of their objects hereabouts. I am deliberately keeping you in the dark with regard to my other contacts so I can work this phase of the check. Could you find out from your various contacts the names of as many space people as possible, and the names and objects of their various projects, and also if they know corresponding particulars of other space people and projects. What I hope to do is to find the same group of people making contact at two or more places not related. So far I have been able to get a few check points but not nearly as many as I would like to have. It would appear that each group works hard to establish a contact and then rests on their laurels thereafter. It doesn't make too much sense.

In a general sense, these are the points I feel are fairly well established. Space people from a number of alien planets are in the vicinity of the earth. Physically, they resemble us quite closely, and are probably of the same basic human stock. Something is about to happen which will be quite serious for the human race on this earth, and probably will have serious repercussions throughout the solar system. The space people intend to minimize the damage and ensure that our race does not perish. That we are rather primitive compared with other races, and under normal circumstances would be left to our own devices to grow up as best we could, but because of some impending crisis, they must now interfere in our affairs, but they intend to keep such interference to an absolute minimum. Beyond this I feel we have little but conjecture to go on and I want to extend our information as far as possible by the cross check method which I proposed above. As I suppose you have gathered, I do not have too much confidence in the detail given by any one contact for the semantic reasons given.

There is one other point on which I am convinced, and that is that these people cannot give us any of their technology unless we are prepared to work it out from scratch. They might give us hints and clues, and confirm when we are on the right track, but I think outright instruction is out, mainly because of semantics. This is all for the present. I shall write again soon, and I am looking forward to further information on your contacts

Dear Mr. Middleton,

Many thanks for your Dec. 4th letter. I withheld answering it until after the Christmas rush.

In attempting to establish communication with the saucers, I can offer very little except to use frequencies which will penetrate the ionosphere. We have used the call M 4 AFFA on frequencies around 20 megacycles. In this business we are all in the kindergarten and all I can say is to try anything and everything until something works.

We were told about a system which uses a radio transmitter as an energy source but a special antenna converter, which radiates doughnut shaped waves, which are not time functions. We built up a couple and find they have the most extraordinary properties. If you wish you could build a unit and try to establish a circuit to our group here in Ottawa. Following are the construction instructions.

One ferrite core, material with the highest possible permeability and dielectric constant, about 8 inches to a foot long, and about 1 inch in diameter. About 20 feet of plastic insulated #14 electric house wire. Starting at the center of the wire and at one end of the core wind on the wire as closely as possible, with the first turn under and then over, so that the winding will be exactly symmetrical. It will start at one end of the core and finish at the other end and will resemble a solenoid with a bifilar winding. It is important that the winding be exactly symmetrical.

When connected to a transmitter, treat it as any normal antenna for loading and tuning. There will be a few points of magnetic domain resonance which will be lossy but anywhere else the device will generate the required waves. It will not matter whether or not the antenna converter is shielded as the doughnut waves go through anything. The most remarkable property of this system is that the waves can be directed MENTALLY.

One of our group here George LaFleur has had quite a bit of success in reaching many amateurs, and I shall ask him to try and contact you on the 14 meter band.

Dear Mr. Middelton,

I must appologize for the long delay in answering your letter of October 8th, but I have been quite busy. Project Magnet has been officially dropped by the Canadian Government for a number of reasons, but I am carrying on with it as a personal project. With the information which we have I expect that there may be some tangible action in the near future.

I have taken note of your interest in the general subject of saucers, and of your background in scientific studies, and should things develope as I expect I shall be communicating wiht you again.

In the meantime I would suggest that you try to establish communication with the saucers on any of the higher frequency bands. I would suggest small loop antennas for both receiving and transmitting as they use a type of wave which such antennas can use. In the event of contact, be sure to keep an accurate transcript of messages both ways for checking later to eliminate hoaxes etc.

With regard to the power system of the saucers, this involves a physics of which we know very little. It extends well beyond our conventional knowledge, which incidently, is not quite as right as we think it is. I regret that I cannot tell you more at the present time.

Dear Mr. Innes;

Thank you for your letter of September 13, and I must appologize for the delay in answering it. As you probably know, the Government has dropped all further official interest in flying saucers, but I am carrying on the work on my own as a private project.

I am quite interested in the information which you so kindly included in your letter, and would like to receive more. The type of information which is of most value to us is that which we can corelate with other sources and check against observations.

Would it be too much trouble to ask if you could let me have a list of the names of as many as possible of the people who operate the saucers? You might enquire if the name AFFA conveys any meaning to them.

As you can readily appreciate we are sadly in need of a new way of life, and would welcome any assistance which a more advanced race could offer. Could you enquire if a landing could be arranged in the vicinity of Ottawa, if complete cooperation were assured at this end?

There are a number of technical matters on which we would like information. Do these people use the same number scale as we do? Do they have the same mathematical constants as we have, ie. 3.14159 and 2.718? Also, is their time scale the same as ours? Does anything happen to their material substances when it is brought close to the earth, or within our atmosphere? Have they a knowledge of our radio systems, and could they arrange to communicate with us by radio?

I would deem it a great favour if you could obtain the above information and pass it along to me, as I feel that it could add considerably to our knowledge of these matters.

Thank you very much for your letter of November 15, and your expressed interest in our activities. Yes, I am the Mr. Smith who was responsible for Project Magnet, but I am afraid that the Press presented our activities in this area very much out of perspective. The enclosed statement may serve to clarify the position.

We have been actively engaged in the study of UFO for about twelve years, and scientific oddities much earlier than this. We came to the conclusion about ten years ago that the UFO were real, of extraterrestrial origin, built and operated by people very much like us, and of whom we are descendants. We have no reason to change these views, and if anything, we are even more convinced now, in the light of our findings in the meantime.

We find that the new look at the Universe is very much simpler, non-mathematical, all-embracing, and contains no anomalies. Also, it opens the door to such things as energy percipitation, gravity control, and attenuationless communications. So far we have had next to no success in getting any appreciable acceptance for these facts, as Scientists persist with religious fervor in worshipping and defending their Golden Calf of orthodoxy, and shouting "Heresoy" when anything inconsistent with established principles is mentioned. However, since it is Truth, it will come eventually.

We do have some people in our Ottawa Flying Saucer Club who can read DISC, and they advise the rest of us on the highlights, but we would very much like have it in English. We most certainly will bring it to the attention of those whom we can reach. We are glad that you find TOPSIDE interesting, and we hope to accelerate our efforts along these lines in future issues.

Dear Dan,

I'm afraid it is quite a while since we have exchanged letters and I feel quite guilty. Mr. Killick told me that he had a very pleasant visit with you folks and brought me partially up to date. I trust that he told you of our activities here, such as they are.

I am enclosing with this letter a bit of the metal that Ken spoke about. This sample is from one side of the big plug which seems to have all the rest of the stuff impaled on it. We have had analyses made of several samples and they are not all the same, but do represent alloys which we earth people don't normally make. It is a mystery. If you would like some more samples just say so and we will belabor the big chunk again with a sledge and see what we can knock off. We haven't yet found a way to cut it and we dare not use a torch as some of the material is violently explosive.

I am due to put on a TV program in the near future and I would like to get a few representative pictures of saucers. I don't know what is available but I thought you might, so if it isn't asking too much could you send me a few. I am enclosing some bucks to cover costs and if more is needed please let me know.

I have now completed the writeup on the New Science, which I have pieced together from the information gathered from many sources, most of which are extra-terrestrial. The actual writing was largely under partial control. The whole work is about 20,000 words or so and takes the evolution of science from the absolute beginning where the Creator started, Nothing-At-All and the basic concepts which the Creator introduced, and their evolution through the twelve parameters of the Universe up to and including the basic principles of Science. Also, it goes beyond modern science in two places, Percipitation of Energy (and Matter) and Gravity Control. The tie-in with conventional science is shown as well as the places where orthodox science is inadequate.

I am still of two minds as to whether or not this knowledge should be released into the world today. Once the step is taken there can be no return, and we have before us the horrible example of Atomic Energy! I would appreciate very much your opinion on this point, because there is no doubt in my mind that these principles are the ones on which the people from "elsewhere" have built their science and the question is, are we ready?

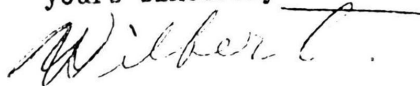
So far I have made no attempt towards publishing because I wanted to think about it for a while, and to get a few outside (and inside) opinions. Some time ago I enquired from some of the people topside about divulging certain information and was told that the time was not right. Also, a few attempts at even limited divulgence were thwarted so I took the hint! Now, I am wondering if the time is right.

I am very disturbed by the current series of nuclear tests because sooner or later energies will be reached which can initiate the Vril reaction, which is the driving together of positive and negative charges to the annihilation of both. An electron driven into a proton will produce an overloaded neutron which will shatter into a long series of violently unstable mesons, until the whole is converted into energy, the majority of the quanta of which are more than sufficient to drive more electrons into protons, and so on. Furthermore, we do not know at what point the reaction will spread to matter other than hydrogen. Maldek.

I still haven't been able to arrange a trip west. It seems as if there is a conspiracy against us getting together. However, I have hopes that we may be able to wrangle something next summer. I still have a month's furlough leave to my credit and I can't think of a better place to enjoy it.

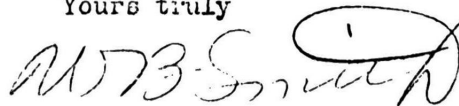
Dear Mr. Bunting,-

Dear Harry,

You seem to have a couple of letters ahead of me, but what with the holiday season and a small family who demand a certain amount of attention, I just didn't get around to writing. I trust that you and yours had a very satisfactory Yuletide.

I am extremely pleased that the plans are going so well, and I wish you all the luck in the world. I think you folks are fortunate indeed to have this big chance.

I shall be looking forward to hearing the tape, and although I might already have been briefed in these matters, another viewpoint will be appreciated. I already have quite a collection of tapes records, transcripts etc. and it is most amazing how they all tell the same thing.

I enjoyed the Dick Miller tape, although it is too big a reel to play on my machine, but one of our group has a machine which takes it OK. It seems that a significant number of contacts are being made these days, and I only hope that they lead to public recognition and National acceptance.

I still have the gravimeter recording but it has been very quiet lately except for about a .001 increase in g on New Years day. I think I shall try building up a light beam transmitter and receiver, just to see if I can get anywhere with it.

I took the liberty of sending a few extracts from your correspondence to AFFA to get his reaction. Following is an extract from his letter;

"I do not quite understand their procedure of the group but I presume they know what they are doing. ... There is a question in my mind just what they can wish to accomplish by such a trip,- of course it is a sightseeing trip but who on your planet will believe them when they return. I would advise you however not to try to venture such a trip,- I feel that you are more valuable right where you are at the present."

The foregoing is representative of AFFA's comments. Apparently there is a Plan which is being meticulously followed and I am involved, but just how, I haven't the faintest idea. All I can gather is that big and terrible things are due to happen shortly and it is their purpose to guide us through the difficulties. Of course I am quite impatient, but they seem to have unlimited quantities of that commodity.

However, I do think that if your trip is successful in the gathering of evidence, and this can be brought to the public's attention, and they accept the reality of the space people and their willingness to help us, we will be better able to face up to anything which may happen. I sincerely hope so.

The boys topside have shown me quite a few of their methods, machine elements, etc but have asked me not to do anything about them yet as there will be a proper time and place in the very near future. I must say that they have liked some of our age old problems in most effective ways, not just approximations as we do it, but entirely and completely with nothing left over. Some of these we could use right now while others depend on materials which we don't yet have. Of course we could make the materials as they do, but the whole involves a sort of chain reaction leading to an entirely new and different civilization. Maybe it is best that they do it their way.

I shall have to close off for the present as the evening is wearing on and I still have much to do. Please don't feel that I am in any way bored with your letters; quite the contrary. I consider them most valuable and interesting. Meanwhile, best of luck.

Dear Harry,

I received the tape OK, as well as your last letter. I enjoyed both very much. I most certainly want the rest of the tapes.

We went down to Maine for Easter week end and I took the tapes and played them for AFFA's contact. Affa confirmed the authenticity of the material, but said that there was a great deal more to both the early history of this planet and Maldec than was given on the tapes, but I guess they wanted to give us only the highlights.

How is the trip coming? Is it postponed indefinitely, or has a date been set? If they don't get around to it pretty soon, things may be too disturbed to go at all.

Incidentally, Rear Admiral H.B. Knowles extends to you and your wife a most cordial invitation to visit them any time soon, when convenient to you. Their address is South Berwick RFD #1, and they live in a little village called Elliot, on Route 106, just across the river from Dover, New Hampshire, in Maine. AFFA's contact lives about a mile along the same road. I think that you would find it most enlightening if you could arrange to pay these folks a visit on your next trip east. They are extremely anxious to get copies of the tapes and will no doubt be writing to you about them soon.

You asked about Williamson and the group at Prescott. I correspond with them, and exchange the odd idea with them, but I am not too familiar with all their activities. I sent a tape to Dan Fry, with a few words on it, which I hope make sense to him. I hope nothing fouls up with this one, as I have recollections of one other.

By the way, in looking over some of your former letters I find some things which are incomplete. You said Dick got married, - to whom, where and when? I would like to know a bit about it. Also, I would like to know something of the mechanism of your contacts, particularly those which produce the tapes.

I am busy these days putting together the basic science which I have learned from the space people. It is very simple, much more so than ours, but there is much more to do before we can use it to make a new technology. However, it is most satisfying to be able at least to see a glimmer of how their devices work, and why we can't seem to get going with our science. I think shortly, that several of us, each of whom seems to be custodian of certain information, should exchange what information we have leading towards a consolidation into the new science. I think that any of us left to his own devices could produce the science alone, but working together might be more effective and quicker. There does however seem to be one outstanding point, the space people are determined to keep this away from the military.

I have a wholesome respect for them, and I realize that if any of us attempt to step out of line, we will be stopped short. I would like to know what your contacts think about this idea?

By the way, do you know if any people from other planets are living in your vicinity? Or do they visit regularly? I have heard rumors that quite a few are living with us, but so far haven't been able to pin the rumor down.

Don't worry about people quoting me, as I am used to it, and have experienced quite a bit, some accurate and some not so accurate. There seem to be a clan of people who are not sincere enough or willing enough to work on the project to attain any kind of contact, but who like to beetle around and represent that they know almost everyone who has anything to do with saucers. I don't think these people do an good or any particular harm; I think they just don't count. So I ignore them.

With best wishes to your wife and your self, and if you do come east, remember you are more than welcome here and the people in Maine would also like to see you.

Accomodation is no problem for us as we have the Kombi in which our whole family can live quite comfortably. AFPA's contact is just down the road from Knowles. Naturally, if you can make it to Ottawa we will be most happy to look after you. Also, there are a few interested people in this area whom I should like you to meet.

Some time ago you requested that I return Tape #1, but I just procrastinated and didn't do it. I wonder if you could send me a new #1? I will of course return

the old one if you wish, but in view of your trip I don't want to risk getting things confused.

I am still plugging away at the basic science and slowly but surely learning. Some wise old philosopher said that there was no royal road to learning and in my opinion that was the understatement of the age! However, when once mastered the whole thing is very simple. Although I still am a long way from knowing exactly how they do all these things which amaze us, I can however, appreciate the principles on which they operate, and I hope some day to close the gap.

I recently made the acquaintance of a fellow, Shelley Presentey, who is a top flight physicist engineer and mathematician. He is a rare combination of enthusiasm and skepticism, and very open minded. He is busy now assimilating what I can teach him, and is eagerly looking forward to applying this technology to the benefit of mankind. He also is adamant that it be NOT made available to the military. So, IF we have time enough we may be able to accomplish something tangible yet.

I am very pleased that the space people are planning a definite demonstration, as I feel sure that is one of the few ways in which their reality can be proven.
