

the copies (it is naturally of nuisance value to them) they are not anxious to do this very often, and it was because of the good relationship I established with Millman that he agreed to let us have a copy. So, rather than over-extending his generosity, if you could ask him to mail it to me (as a CAPRO member), I could then make my own copy and pass his to you for retention in the CAPRO files. How does this sound to you?

I read the minutes of Project Second Story, which was the DRB committee of 1952-53. These were downgraded to Unclassified by special effort of Millman a few weeks ago. However, there is nothing of special interest in them. All the committee did was to examine interrogation procedures and develop a reporting form, with a set of instructions for observers to use in observing and reporting. Their work just got forgotten about, but perhaps it could be resurrected if needed.

I asked Dr. Millman about the U. of Toronto study, and if he knows what they are doing. He said it seems they are doing nothing as far as he can see. He says he has heard nothing from them.

This completes my report. I wish it could be more comprehensive and detailed, but I only had the one day to study the files. However, I believe I got the meat of it.

Now, a few words about Annex "A". Being a member of DND myself, I cannot say anything publicly about DND without DND's prior permission. I therefore had to submit this paper to them for clearance. This has been obtained. In fact, they were most helpful to me in clarifying one or two points. Nothing has been deleted.

I have received my copy of the latest bulletin and it is excellent. I am very pleased with your review of my book and I want to thank you very much. I am indeed grateful to you.

I hope this report is of some value to you.
