

He continually made reference to the smell and the heat which apparently made a lasting impression on him.

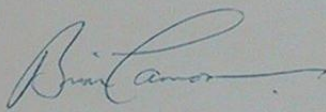
There have been numerous references to the Luminous Paint theory by Dr. Saunders in UFOs! Yes! and by Dr. Condon himself. I have written to Dr. Millman pointing out that the Radium 226 found in the soil samples and providing fuel for the radium paint hypothesis, was also found on the metal fragments as being the source of radioactivity.
