Crashes

The first crash known to have occurred was in Roswell, New Mexico in July 1947.

A rancher was looking for his cattle the day after a thunder storm when he saw wreckage from something. He called up the local Air Force. They came and blocked off the area. The Air Force said that it was just a weather balloon after they got all the pieces. The metal was as thin as paper and they couldn't bend it with a 16 lb. sludge hammer.

Stories circulated that the pieces were flown to Wright Patterson Air Force Base in Ohio.

Stories also circulated by medical people that claimed to have worked on autopsies, that four alien bodies were found and also flown out.

Photo 4-1 shows researchers at the original crash sight looking for metal that might have been overlooked by the Air Force.

Among the many other stories of crashes, there is one that occurred on December 9, 1965 in Kecksburg, Pennsylvania. There had been numerous reports all across the state of a crashing object.

There were eight volunteer fire men that went into the bush to investigate. They found an acorn shaped object with writing on the bumper.

There was numerous reports of a flaming U.F.O crashing high up into the mountain.

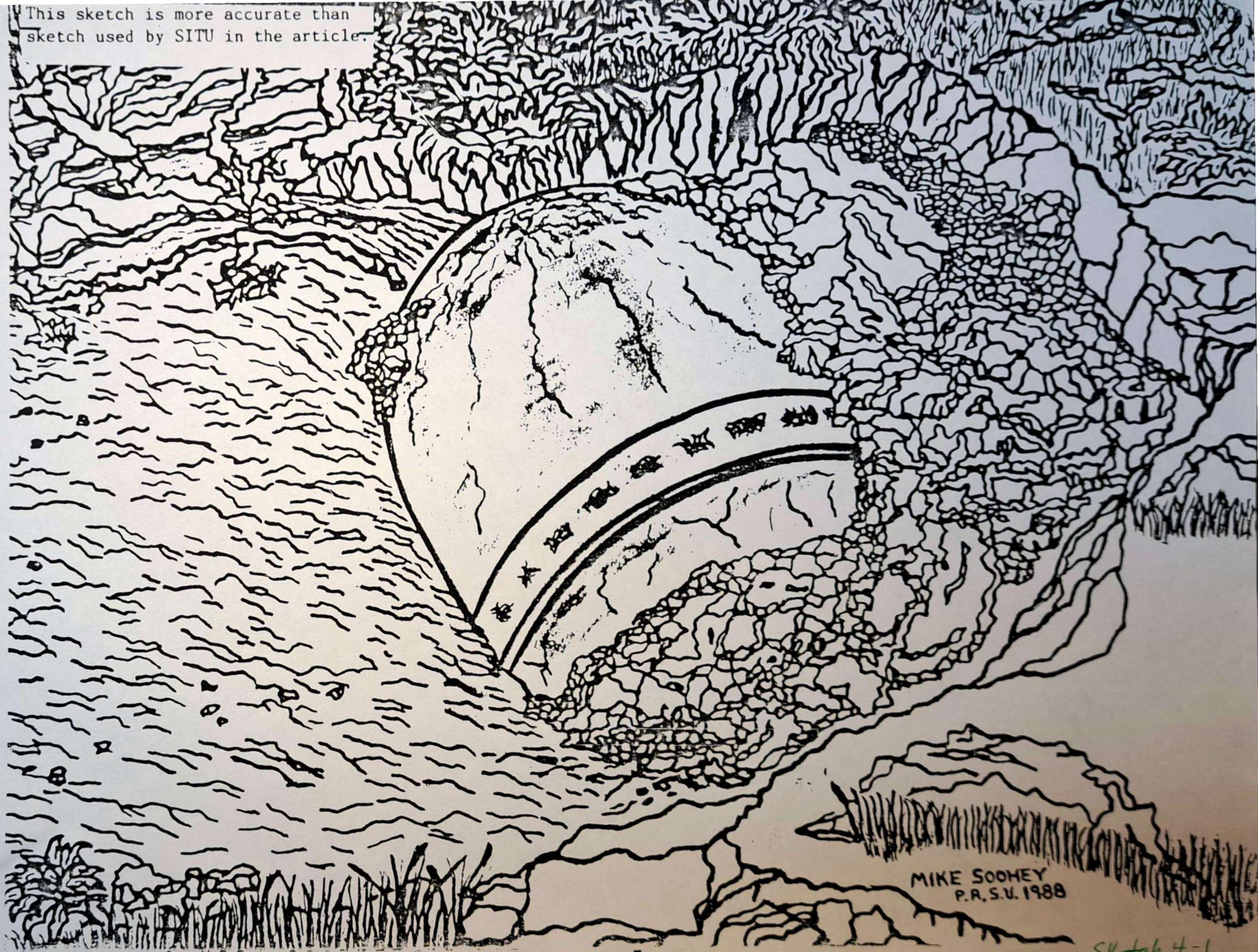

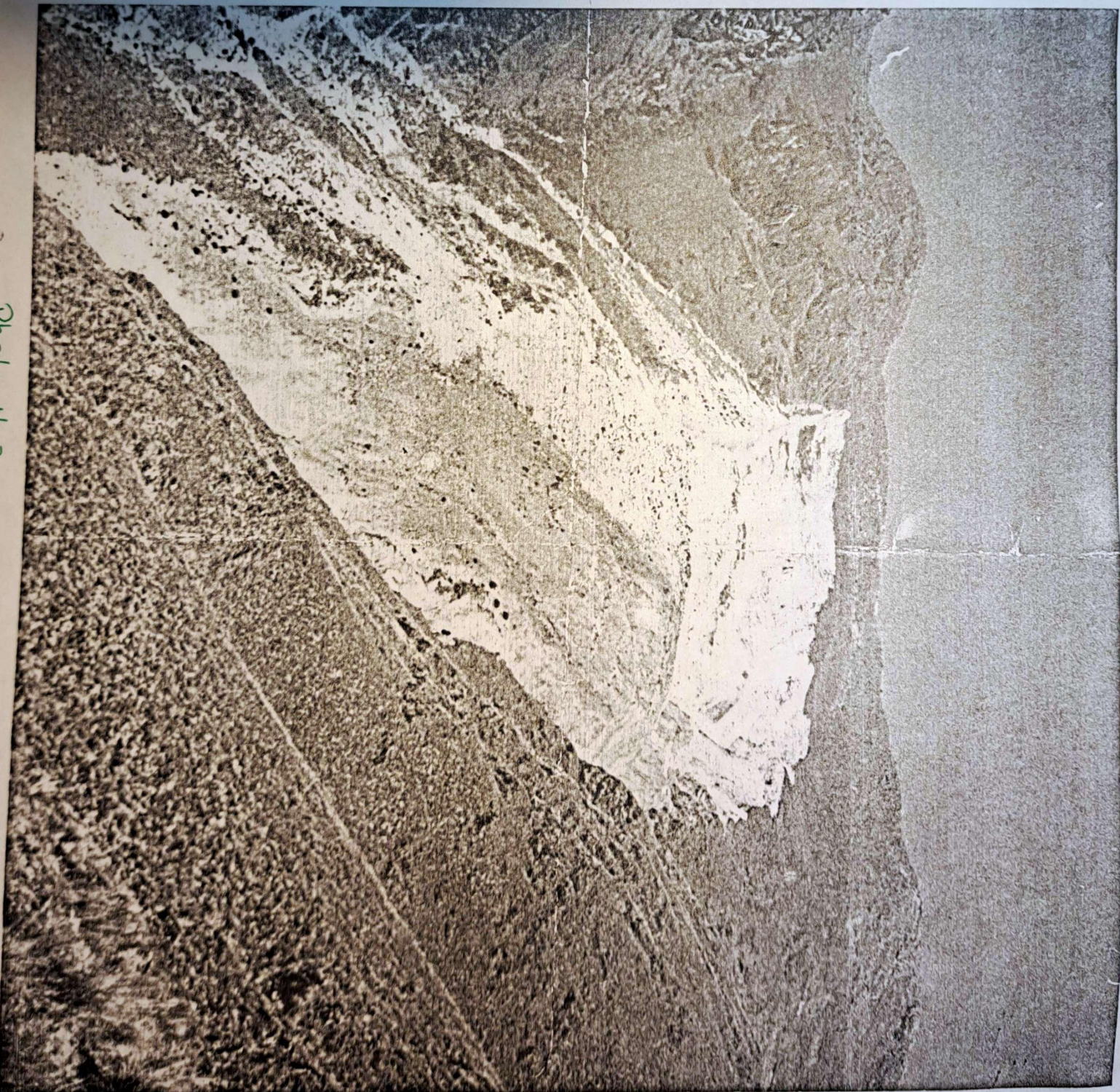

Cattle Mutilations

The Cattle Mutilations started in 1969. Over the years there ~~has~~ been thousands of them.

Most of them take place in the mid west. The hardest hit place in Canada is in Alberta. The hardest hit in U.S.A. is Colorado.

In Canada the R.C.M.P. checked it out and in the U.S. the F.B.I. checked it out.

The logic is - that a human being could not have done this ~~at~~ because the cuts are very precise, ^{S.S.} no sign of struggle, ^{no drugs} no drugs used, no blood, no odor and no tire tracks or footprints.

Enclosed is a ^{actual} report of a cattle mutilation in Pincher Creek Alberta, Complete with pictures.

Pincher Creek, 14 August, 1989

Monday, August 14, 1989, I met at her home Mrs. Laura Afdahl, approximately 55 years old, about her mutilated cow. Her address is:

According to her testimony, it seems that one of her best cows has been the victim of an act of mutilation. This event occurred at Brocket, an Indian reserve of Alberta, between Pincher Creek and Fort Macleod. On this farm, one night, a cow as we can see on the photographs, seems to have been the victim of a "gang" searching for "odd" sensations or the object of an experience madden by an unknown person or persons.

I had an interview with Mrs. Afdahl and I went in the field where I found the bones of the mutilated cow. Despite the time that had passed, I could see, on the bones of one leg, some flesh and some fur. However, I could not smell any rottenness odor.

Mr. Brian Adams, from the RCMP (Royal Canadian Mounted Police), and Mr. Jan Allen, gamekeeper on the indian reserve, have come to see the mutilations on the cow. Mr. Adam has produced a report about this case but did not say anything to Mrs. Afdahl. The officers of the RCMP of Pincher Creek have refused to give us any details concerning this case or any other cases of mutilated cattle in the area of Pincher Creek.

ABOUT THE ANIMAL:

- The magpie was missing, and the "cutting" was very "clean".
- No blood, neither on the animal or on the ground. No rottenness odor
- No flies on the remains of the cow.
- Some pink fluid, like colored water, has been found near the mutilated cow
- Mr. Charlie Zachar, veterinarian, has practiced a post-mortem examination on the cow but, except the point ever mentioned, he did not find anything unusual.
- No trace (footprints or tires tracks) around the mutilated cow.
- No predator has eaten the cow until the following year, despite the fact that the cow had been left where she had been found.

"The cows must be 8 months before we could sell them. My husband and my son Jan were on the hills to gather them together in order to get them in the truck that should drive them to the slaughter-house.

Shortly after the supper, this 20 October 1988, after having brought together the herd, they (my husband and my son) reported a missing cow. Then, my son Jan went wandering in the fields, and finally he found her.

She was in a ditch, lied dead. Her magpie was missing and Jan has immediately called his father that have established the death of the cow too. They have examined the cow and they concluded that the mutilation was probably the cause of the death. The cutting around the missing magpie had the form of a petal.

I was not at home that night, but when I came back the following morning, they informed me that one of our best cows had been mutilated somewhere on the hill. I asked them: "Did you call the police?" My husband answered: "No! We didn't want to be laughed at!" "We didn't want the police to think that we were crazy!" Then, I said: "I want to know what happen to my cow..." I climbed on the hill and I took some pictures of the beast and I came back to the farm to call the RCMP (Royal Canadian Mounted Police). I talked to the officer on duty, at the police station of Pincher (Pincher Creek, Alberta, CANADA), and I asked him: "Are you aware about recent mutilated cattle?" This officer, a young indian from Brocket, not too far from here, answered me: "You know, there have been other mutilated cows last week, just West of Pincher Creek", he said, "but I don't know which part of the animal was missing". I think that he said that it was probably the genital organs that were missing on these animals. But the other officer that came here, M. Brian Adams, accompanied by Mr. Jan Allen, gamekeeper, did not say anything about these other mutilated cattle. He concluded that the cow had been probably killed by wild predators. But when he moved the cow for further examination, he was amazed by the fact that no blood was visible, neither on the cow or on the ground. Only a strange fluid, a pink solution, has been found under the head of the cow.

There was no other trace, as human footprints or animal footprints, around the dead cow."
