Dear Mr. Bray:

I regret the rather lengthy delay involved in the analysis of the metal sample with which you provided me. To date, I have had no word from the laboratory.

In early September, I turned the piece of metal over to an employee of Ontario Hydro, presently working in a generating station in Toronto. The metal was tagged as being a piece of boiler tube metal, and was forwarded to the Ontario Hydro Research Division in Toronto for a complete metallurgical analysis. As I understand that this laboratory does very detailed work, and handles a large volume of material, this no doubt accounts for the time lag.

I will, of course, forward a copy of the laboratory report as soon as it is received.
