I HEARD A SOUND SIMILAR TO THAT
OF HEAVY TRUCKS TIRES AS THEY WHINE
ON A WET HIGHWAY — THEN A ROAR OF A
MOTOR AS IN PRE-FLIGHT WARM-UP.

THIS STRANGE A/C, ROUND AND FLAT
CAME INTO VIEW — IT HAD THREE OR FOUR
LARGE ROUND, BRILLIANT LIGHTS AND SMALLER
LIGHTS IN BETWEEN THE LARGER ONES.

THESE LIGHTS APPEARED TO ROTATE
FROM LEFT TO RIGHT — IN COURSE OF FLIGHT.
