1. Memphis AFB had T-11 a/c in this area, had red wings, tail. Pilot over Greenwood at 2105.

THE OBJECT SIGHTED. CIVILIAN AIR PATROL AT GREENVILLE, MISS. REPORTED SIGHTING THE SAME OBJECT OVER GREENVILLE AT 2129C. MEMPHIS ARTC ALERTED MISS. AND TENN. HIGHWAY PATROLS. MEMPHIS AFB REPORTED THAT A T-11 AIRCRAFT LANDED THERE AT 2230C. AIRCRAFT HAD RED WINGS, TAIL, AND PASSING LIGHTS AND LOODED "WIERD". PILOT OF AIRCRAFT SAID THAT HE WAS OVER GREENWOOD AT 2105C, CIRCLED TWICE, AND SIGHTED ANOTHER AIRCRAFT IN AIR. HE THEN PROCEEDED TO GREENVILLE WHICH HE ALSO CIRCLED.
