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On 29 April 1952, at 0830 hours the following report was submitted to the undersigned by the Officer of the Day relative to sightings of unconventional aircraft on 27 April 1952:

Mr. [REDACTED] Royal Oak, Michigan, phone [REDACTED] 31, talked to the undersigned concerning flying saucer he saw at approximately 1100 hours, 27 April 1952. He said he saw a small white object very high in the sky. It looked like a paper plate. As he watched it, it turned sideways. It seemed to be stationary. Mr. [REDACTED] reported he went into the house to get his binoculars and when he came out, it was gone. He called a neighbor as a witness, but the neighbor could not see it.

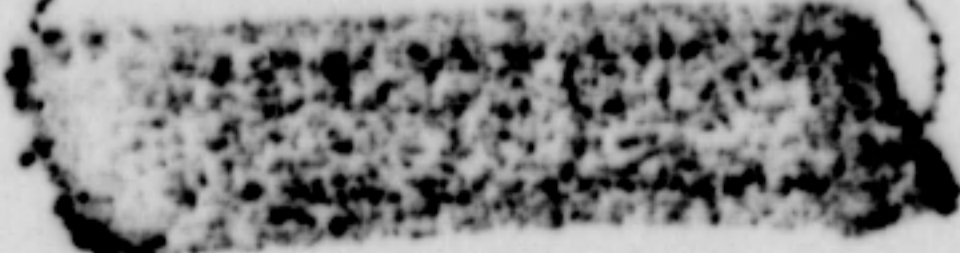
