WOMAN REPORTING SIGHTING AT APPROXIMATELY SAME TIME DESCRIBED SAME TYPE FORMATION BUT ON A SOUTHERLY COURSE FORMATION THEN DID A 360 AND CONTINUED SOUTH. OBJECTS DISPLAYED NO TRAIL OR EXHAUST NO SOUND. OTHERS IN ADJOINING CARS ARE REPORTED TO HAVE COMMENTED ON THIS SIGHTING. THE SECOND POINT OF SIGHTING AT APPROXIMATELY THE SAME TIME WAS FROM ANOTHER DRIVE-IN THEATER IN N SPOKANE 47 43N 117 25W. TWO LUMINOUS WHITE DISCS HAD⁰² BEEN SEEN EARLIER AT 2045 TRAVELING RAPIDLY NE TO SW IN LINE FORMATION. DUE TO LIGHT OF DUSK THIS SIGHTING WAS HAZY. SUBSEQUENT⁰³ SIGHTING AT 2230 WAS OF A SINGLE DISC DESCRIBED AS LOOKING LIKE CLAY PIGEON LUMINOUS WHITE CAME OUT OF NE AND DISAPPEARED IN SW BEHIND THEATER SCREEN DROPPING TOWARDS HORIZON. SIZE OF THIS LATTER OBJECT WAS COMPARED TO ONE-SIXTH THE SIZE OF A FULL MOON LARGER THAN ANY STAR. NO TRAIL OR EXHAUST REPORTED. ELAPSED TIME OF SINGLE DISC TWO TO THREE SECONDS. RELIABILITY OF CIVILIAN REPORTERS CANNOT BE EVALUATED. RELIABILITY OF MAJOR ~~REDACTED~~ GOOD. IN EACH REPORT THERE WAS MENTION OF MANY OTHERS IN VICINITY ALSO OBSERVING OBJECT
