1. Description: Steady white light, no distinguishable shape, a little larger than a navigation light. No vapor or trail and no sound. Moving a little faster than normal aircraft travel, but not as fast as a meteor. Object wavered on course.

2. Time Sighted: 1959C, 15 August 1952.

3. Manner of Observation: Visual-surface.

4. Location of Observer: W Long 97°08', N Lat 32°43'. [REDACTED] Dallas, Texas. Object sighted about 85 degrees above horizon traveling North-Northeast approximately one-half mile West of Observer. Object disappeared in approximately twenty seconds twenty degrees above horizon Northwest of Observer.

5. Identifying Information on Observer: Observer was [REDACTED] Drive, Dallas, Texas, Major in Marine Reserve, more than average intelligence, steady, mature person. No other witnesses.

6. Weather: 2000C 015 069/96/70↑R 15/978

7. Other Activity: None reported.

8. Physical Evidence: No physical evidence or photographic evidence obtained.

9. Interception or Identification: No attempt was made to intercept or identify the object.
