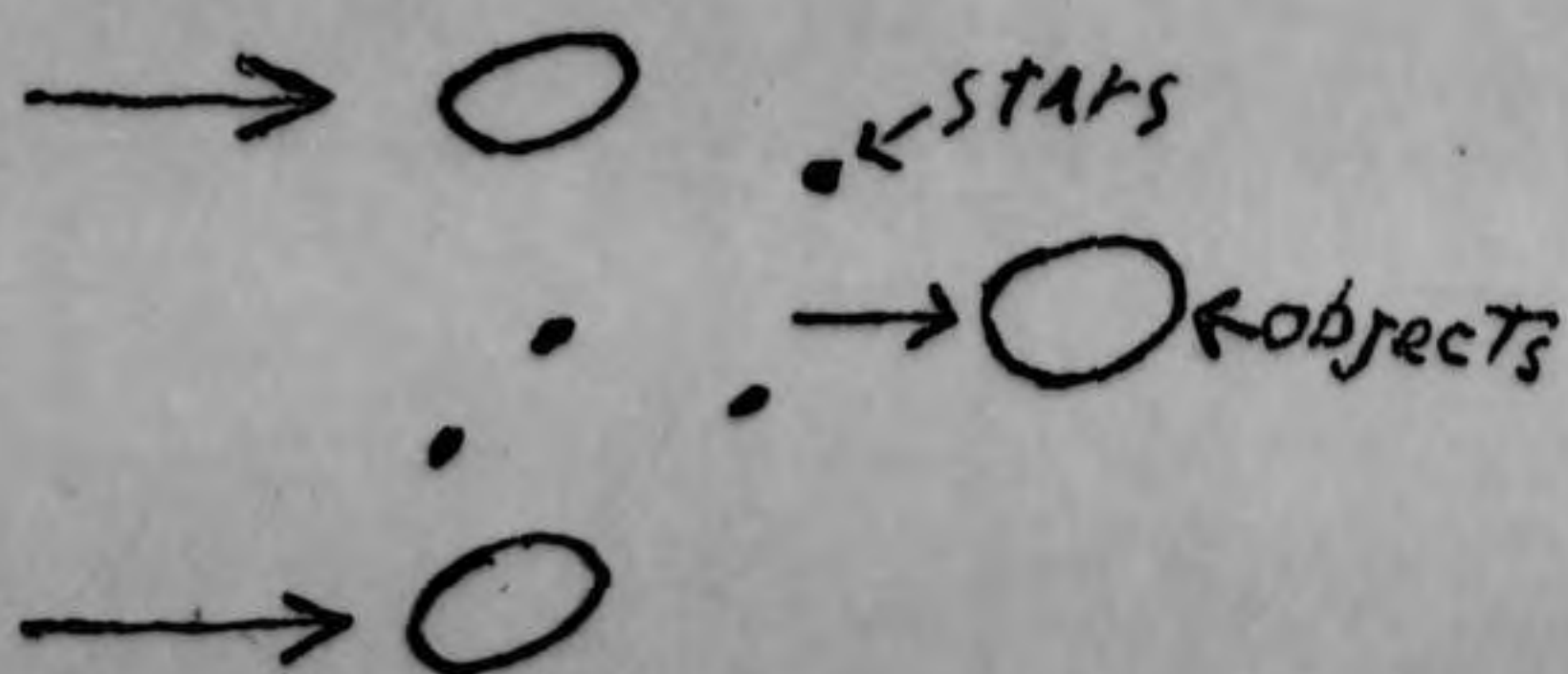

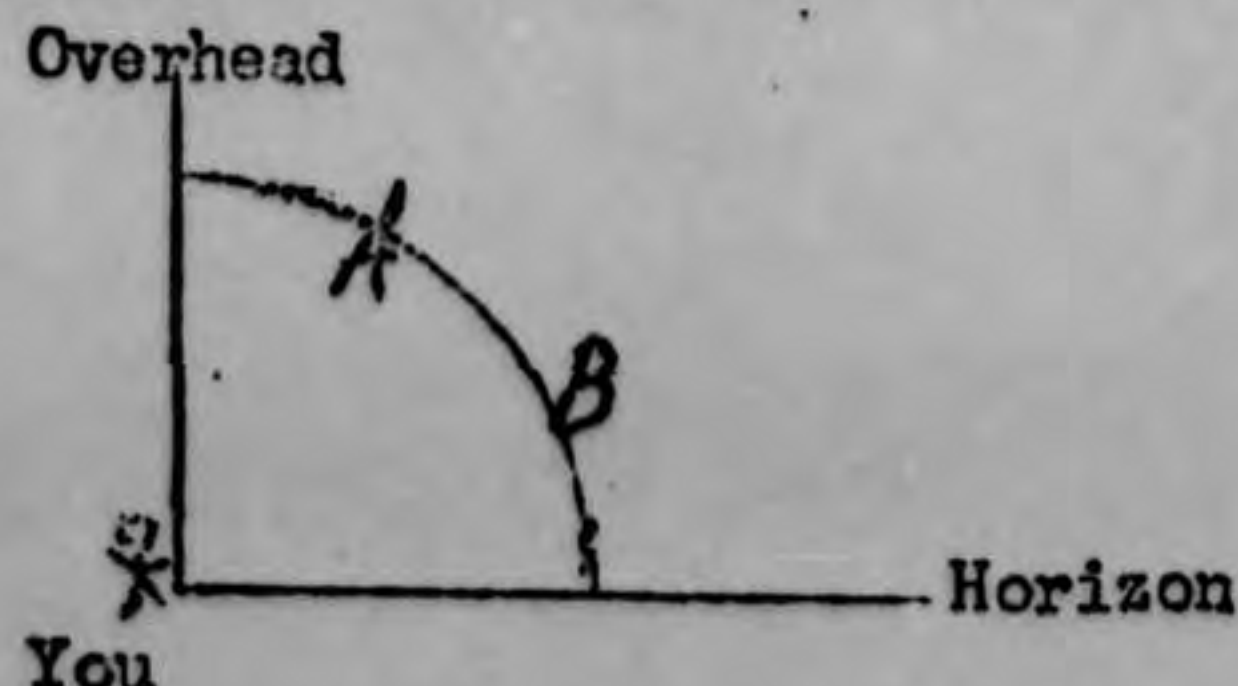

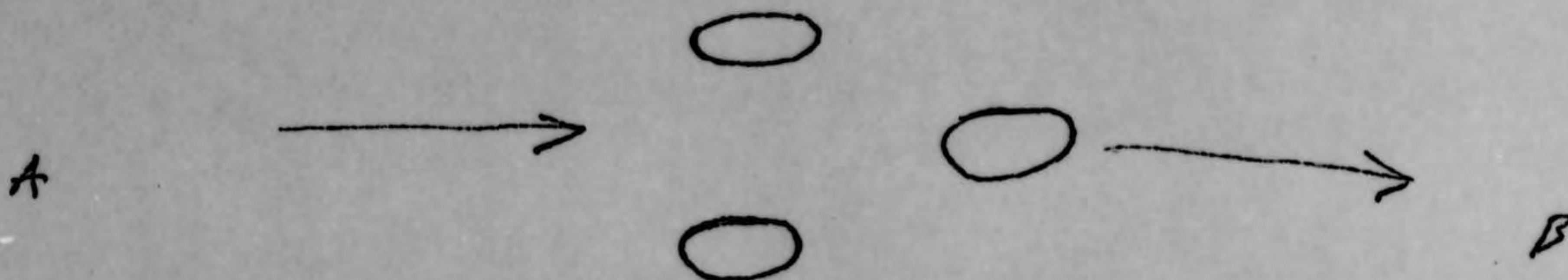

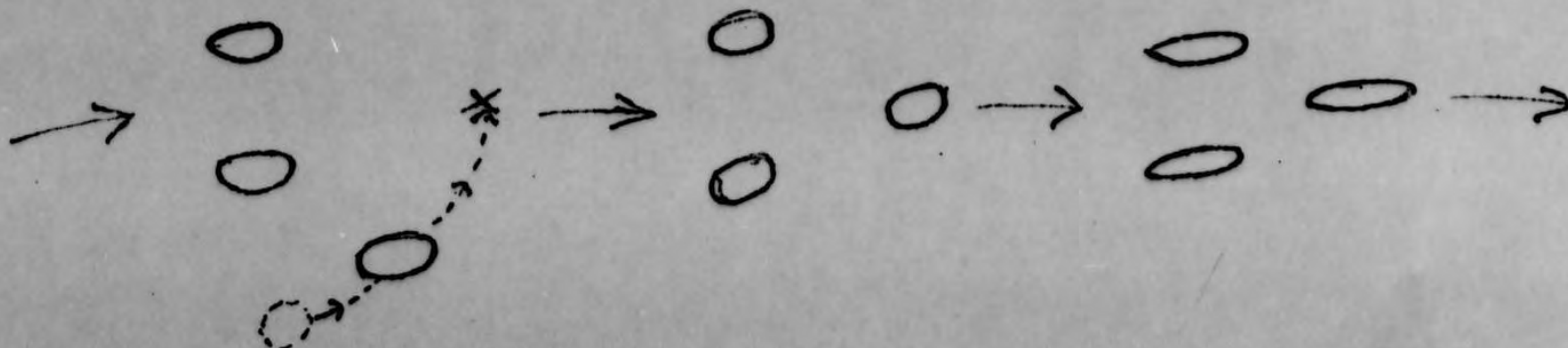
23. In the following sketch place an "A" at the position the object was when you first saw it, and a "B" at its position when you last saw it.
