1. One oblong shaped object, very large, silver colored, dome on top with flashing light inside dome, making no sound and did not emit any type of exhaust.
2. Object was noticed on horizon and observed for approximately 15 minutes, finally disappearing straight up.

4. Object was sighted at 24 April 1954 at 2310Z hours (Dusk) and remained in sight for 15 minutes.
