ZERO ZEBRA, A LARGE ROUND, BIRGHT OBJECT WAS REPORTED SEEN NEAR HARLOWTOWN MONT. FOURTY SIX DEGREES FOURTY SEVEN MIN. NORTH, ONE ONE ZERO DEGREES EIGHT MIN. WEST. THE OBJEXT WAS LIKD A LARGE STAR, MOVING VERY SLOWLY ANDISSAPPERING AND REAPPERING IN A DIFFERANT POSITION. IT CHANGED COLORS FREQUENTLY BUT HAD A CONTINUOUSLY GLOWING ORGANE RIM. IT WAS VERY BRIGHT, AND OBSERVED BY DR. [REDACTED] AGE THRITY ONE, [REDACTED] HARLOWTON MONT., A MEDICAL DOCTOR, AND SEVERAL OTHER RELIABLE WITNESSES.
